SPECIAL MEETING
MONDAY JULY 19, 1976
10:00 A.M.

A special meeting of the Tyler County Commissioner's Court met on Tuesday July 19, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. All members were present and the meeting opened with a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to pay annual dues to Deep East Texas Council of Government in the amount of \$596.68. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to appoint the following elected officials to be members of the Board of DECOG: Austin Fuller, Patricia Brown, James R. Jordan and Allen Sturrock. All voted yes, none voted no.'

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to table the appointment of Election Judges until Monday July 27, 1976 at 9:00 A.M. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to approve the Tyler County contributions to MHMR in the amount of \$7,067.00. This amount to be in 1977 budget and to be paid in 1977. See attached information. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Parks to advertise for bids on repairs to Courthouse as follows: (ceiling in District Judge's office, replace carpet in hall, move air conditioner's in Jury Room, paint probation department area, change locks, replace door leading to roof, paint Courtroom, bids to be opened at 9:00 A.M. on the 16th day of August 1976. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to budget Revenue Sharing to Entitlement VI fourth quarter as follows: Allen Shiver's Library \$2,500.00, repairs on Courthouse \$5,000.00, Jail Construction Fund \$16,172.00, Solid Waste \$10,000.00 (which includes \$5,000.00 from July 16th minutes) and \$7,944.00 unencumbered for a total of \$41,616.00. See attached list. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to authorize County Auditor to set up Work Shops on budget with each elected official. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to allocate Revenue Sharing to Road and Bridge pct. on mileage and bridge formula as the following: (Pct. 1,1240) (Pct. 2,2165) (Pct. 3,3305) (Pct. 4,3290). For Commissioner Fowler, Jordan, and County Judge Mann. Against Commissioner Best and Parks.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best to table bids submitted on sale of junk bodies for further study. See bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Parks to approve low bid from Joe Hensarling of \$400.00 for mowing Airport and to award him the contract. See attached bids. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Parks to accept low bid from Flatt Stationeries of Mexia, Texas for 250 reems 8½ X 14 \$2.00 a reem and 50 reems of 8½ X 11 \$1.50 a reem. See attached bid. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to approve an expense account for Rev. Jesse Adams chairman Aging Committ for a trip to Austin. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to table the question of County participation in the Home Repairs for Aging of Tyler County. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Best that the same formula be applied to distribution of funds out of the Road & Bridge Pct. funds on projects on a County wide basis as applied to funds going into the Pct. Road & Bridge funds.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to table bids for Sheriff's car unopened. All voted yes, none voted no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to advertise for bids on chain link fence to be constructed around County barns in Pct. 3 and Pct. 4. Bids to be opened August 6, 1976 at 9:00 A.M. See each Commissioner for specifications. All voted yes, none voted no.

The Court reconvened until 1:00 P.M.

The Court reconvened at 1:00 P.M.

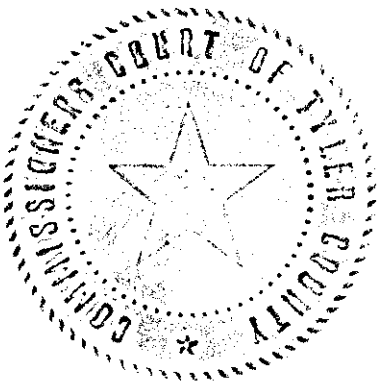
A motion was made by Commissioner Parks and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to reject all bids for Sheriff's car and that the Sheriff continue to use present vehicle. For were Commissioner Fowler, Parks, County Judge Mann. Against were Commissioner Best and Jordan.

A motion was made by Commissioner Best and seconded by Commissioner Parks to set a meeting at 9:00 A.M. Friday 23rd of July and to invite the public and the Tyler County Executive Committee to meet with the Court to consider the appointment of a County Judge. All voted yes, none voted no.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

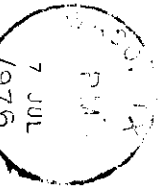

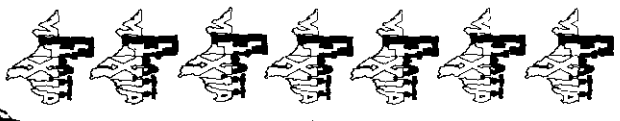
