Commissioner Jordan made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Parks to approve the County Extension Service report for July, 1976. All voted yes and none voted no.

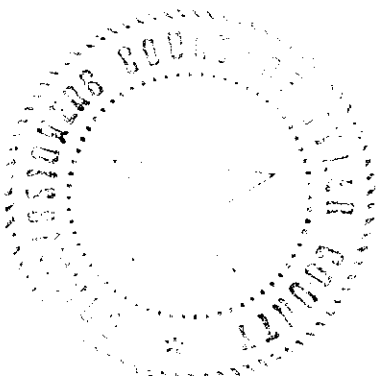
