The special meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Tuesday, September 7, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. The meeting opened with a prayer with all members present.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to leave the tax rates the same as last year. The Tax rates for 1977 Budget will be as follows: County Tax - .80; ROW I&S - .05; Sp. R&B - .10; Lateral Rd. - .30; Hospital - .15; and that the Ratio Assessment stay at 28%. See attached copy. This was seconded by Commissioner Fowler.
All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Parks made a motion to pay the bill on two people sent to Dr. Jinnette by Judge Mann to be paid from Revenue Sharing in the amount of \$161.00. See attached bill. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to permit the County Clerk to take bids on a typewriter. Bids will be opened at 10:00 A.M. September 27, 1976. This is to be paid out of Revenue Sharing. This was seconded by Commissioner Jordan.
All voted yes and none voted no.

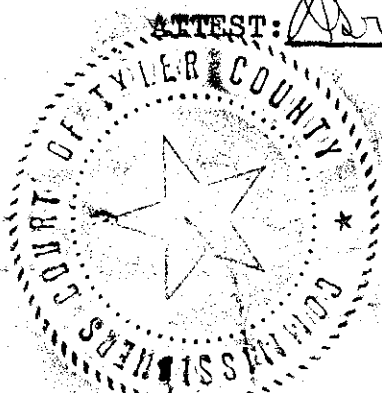
