The regular meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Monday, September 27, 1976 at 10:00 a.m. The meeting was opened with a prayer and all members present except H. M. Parks, Commissioner Pct. #2.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to write Mrs. Francis Barnhart a purchase order for \$20.00 to Big Star for groceries. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to accept the bid from Lufkin Typewriter Co. as the best bid in the amount of \$612.90. This was seconded by Commissioner Fowler. It is to be paid for through Revenue Sharing. See the attached bids. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to accept bid from Ogden Chevrolet, Inc. for \$6,950.00. This was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. The truck is for Pct. #3. See attached bids. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accepted the bid from Jack Lane Ford, Inc. for a truck for Pct. 4 in the amount of \$8,000.00. This was seconded by Commissioner Best. A & M Motor Co. had no trucks to bid on. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to loan Heritage Gardens the use of the antique desk in the hall of the Courthouse. This was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. It will remain the property of Tyler County and an appropriate plaque will be placed on it concerning the history. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to give authority to lock the upstairs restrooms on the weekends. This was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none voted no.

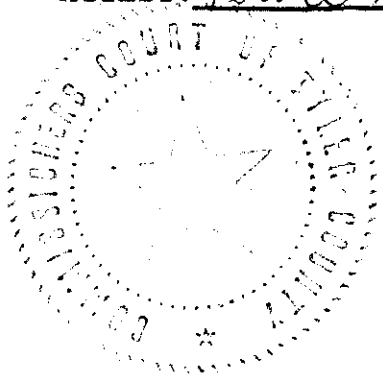

The old machine will be used as a trade-in and time warrants will be issued to pay balance. Bids will be accepted and opened at 10:00 a.m. on October 15, 1976. All voted yes and none voted no.
