

TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT
SPECIAL MEETING
December 28, 1976
10:00 A. M.

The special meeting of the Commissioner's court met on Tuesday, December 28, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. The meeting was opened with a prayer with all members present.

Commissioner Best made a motion to resolve to adopt the amendment for the 1977 Budget. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to adopt the salary schedule as hereby submitted (column 6 - recommended by the auditor). See attached copy. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to adopt the road in Woodland Hills Subdivision - plat file 174 - See attached copy. Commissioner Jordan seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Best made a motion to table bids on Gas, Oil, & Supplies for 1977. Commissioner Fowler seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

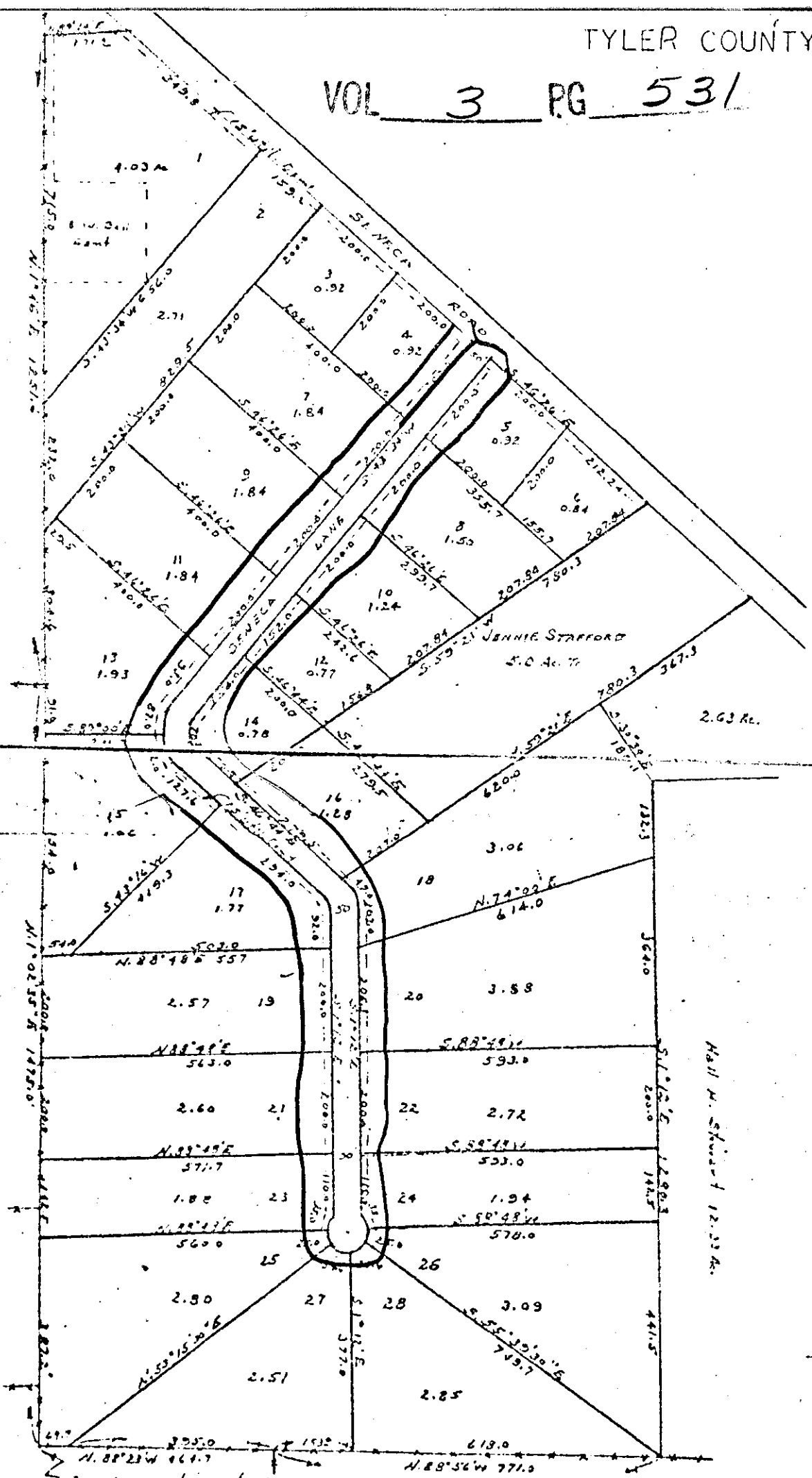
