Commissioner Jordan made a motion to approve monthly report from the County Extension Office. Commissioner Riley seconded this motion.
All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to approve the County Treasurer's report. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion.
All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to table the approving of the number of employees for each office. Commissioner Riley seconded this motion.
All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to set January, April, July, and October as the terms of Court. Commissioner Fowler seconded this motion.
All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Lowe made a motion to appoint Maxie Riley, Commissioner Pct. #1 as the airport manager and supervisor. Commissioner Fowler seconded this motion.
All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to appoint Allen Sturrock as the Courthouse manager and supervisor. Commissioner Jordan seconded this motion.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to approve the \$3,000.00 tax exemption for the persons over 65 and that are 65. Commissioner Riley seconded this motion.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to adopt a resolution saying that the County Officials will be paid on a salary basis for 1977. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to approve Leon Fowler as Solid Waste supervisor. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Lowe made a motion to table the Insurance Coverage until January 17, 1977. Commissioner Jordan seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to Commend Reverend Adams for his service on the Mini Bus and to make the report a part of the minutes. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion that since no bids were submitted on the Gas and Oil, etc. that the Court enter into a contract with J. E. Gardner Oil. Commissioner Riley seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to accept the set holidays for 1977. See attached copy. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to advertise for bids for a depository for the County, School, and Hospital. Commissioner Jordan seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Lowe made a motion to pass a resolution to clear the account on Road and Bridge 6 from the Chester State Bank authorizing Kenneth Lowe to withdraw the \$4.36 and deposit in Citizens State Bank. Commissioner Fowler seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

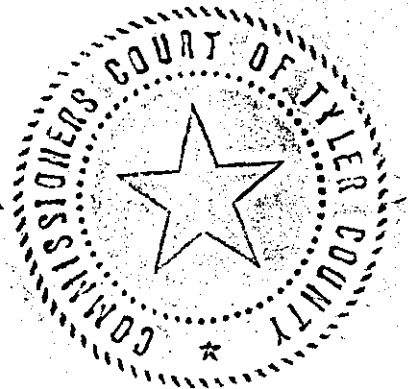
Commissioner Riley made a motion to approve the bills as submitted by the Auditor's office. Commissioner Jordan seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.
