The Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Monday February 7, 1977 at 10:00 A.M. The meeting was opened with Commissioner James Robert Jordan serving as Pro-Tem County Judge. All members were present.

Commissioner Maxie Riley made the motion confirming James R. Jordan to serve as Pro-Tem County for the year of 1977. Comm. Fowler seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to table any recommendation of House Bill numbers 160 and 134, for further study. Comm. Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Lowe made the motion to approve expenses for Dist. Clerk and County Clerk to attend seminar at A. & M. March 1, 2, and 3. Comm Riley seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made the motion to table the appointing of Airport Zoning Commissioner, until further study. Comm. Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to post a Notice for Public hearing on February 14, 1977 at 10:00 A.M. on the use of Federal Revenue Sharing Funds. Comm. Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Fowler made a motion to approve Deputy for District Clerk's Office, under the CETA Program. This will be for 90 days. Comm. Riley seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.

Commissioner Riley made the motion to accept the Bid from Story-Wright for a Desk and Chair for the office of Tax-assessor and Collector, The cost of \$387.00. Comm Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley made the motion to give Comm. Leon Fowler the authority to hire two men to clean the County Jail, and give Comm. Maxie Riley the authority to get proposals to repair the Jail. Comm. Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none voted no.
