The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday October 10, 1977, at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Rev. R.C. Tillery, Jr.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Comm. Riley to approve the County Treasurer's Report. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Comm. Lowe to approve the County Extension Report. All voted yes and none no

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Comm. Riley to table the Bids on Grader Machine for Pct. # III.

Commissioner Riley made the motion which was seconded by Comm. Lowe to accept the Preliminary Report from Carl Nichols, on the Tyler County Fair--Air Show, 1977. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Comm. Lowe to approve the Forms 16, 17 and 18, from the Tax-Assessor-Collector, Barbara Tolbert. All voted yes and none no.
