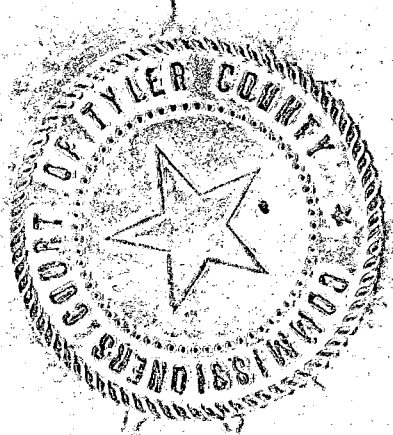

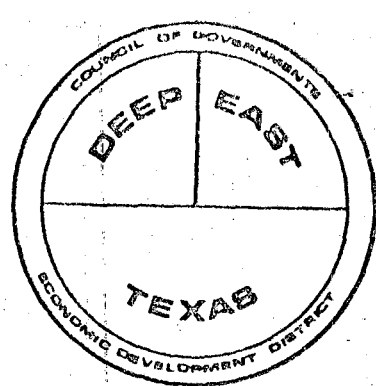


Dear Member:
