The bridge was found to have been constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications. Appearance and workmanship were excellent and it is recommended that the County make final acceptance of the project. With this in mind, it is further recommended that the contractor's performance bond be released and the payment bond released pending receipt of contractor affidavit of all bills paid.

The contractor requested permission to remove barricades from the project but was instructed to leave them in place until the commissioner was contacted and approval given by him for removal.
