The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday December 11, 1978 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present except Commissioner James R. Jordan. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the Records of the County School Supts. Office. Thru the County School Supt. Geo. Barclay, by request of the State School Board, the School Census Records and the three County School Board Minutes, will be filed in the County Clerk's Office. The Financial Records, go to the County Treasurer. The County Judge will control the Furniture. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Riley to form a committee, to study the cost and possibility of government aid to complete the Hot-Meal Program for the Aged. This committee consists of Commissioner's Lowe and Riley with Tom Burk of KVLL Radio Station. This report is expected to be made Friday December 15, 1978. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the County Treasurer's Monthly Report, as submitted. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve the County Extension Monthly report. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the road in Ponderosa Garden, and the County Attorney, Rois Brockman, will prepare a Resolution, which will be adopted. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner ~~Lowe~~ and seconded by Commissioner ~~Fowler~~ to amend the Revenue Sharing Budget, that was allotted to the Probation Dept., but to table the division of such. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve "No Smoking" signs for the District Courtroom, during court of 188th District in Judge Lawlis' Court. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the appointment of Dr. John Q. Gilchrist for County Health Officer, for Tyler County, for a period of two years. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the distribution of the money, sent to Tyler County in Lieu of Taxes on Big Thicket land, for districts relating to schools, in the County; effected by land purchased in the amounts as indicated by Corps of Engineers. These school districts effected are as listed; Warren, \$9101.05--Woodville, \$494.50, and Spurger \$5462.86. All voted yes and none no.

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A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley for the District Clerk, to use the County School Supt. Office, when it is vacated at the end of the year 1978. All voted yes and none no.
