A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Friday January 12, 1979, at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen ~~Sturrock~~.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the request of County Treasurer Austin Fuller to attend the Civil Defense Seminar in Austin Texas, on February 20, 21 and 22, 1979. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to grant permission to Texas City Refining, Inc. of Texas City, Texas to construct a pipeline which will necessitate crossing County Roads, at a location indicated on the Plat attached. This motion was made with the stipulation to change the wording of Public to County roads. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to set a date of Monday January 15, 1979, at 1:00 P.M. for a Work-shop by the Commissioners and Tax-Assessor-Collector to discuss and advertise for bids, for Construction of a one story addition to the Tax Office (adjacent to the Courthouse) with one building alternate and an alternate bid for reroofing the main roof of the Courthouse. All voted yes and none no. ~~Plat attached.~~

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table the appointment of a County Historical Survey Commission, until a future date. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve of paying the Monthly Bills, as submitted by the County Auditor, Ann Fondren, with speculations to the Sheriff's Department, that each one who wears a Badge, will return the Badge, or pay for it, at the termination of their position. All voted yes and none no. Bills attached.

Commissioner Odom made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler to approve the request of Tyler County District Attorney, Geo. Kirkpatrick, for furniture, for Probation Office, excluding the Radio. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Odom to take Inventory of bridges on County Roads, that need to be replaced, and send specifications to Mr. Young, who is with the Highway Dept. of Texas. A letter will be mailed and a copy is hereby attached. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to advertise for bids on used, unneeded grader and Junk, to be seen at Commissioner Pct. #4 Barn, Spurger, Texas. Bids to be opened February 12, 1979. All voted yes and none no. Bid attached.

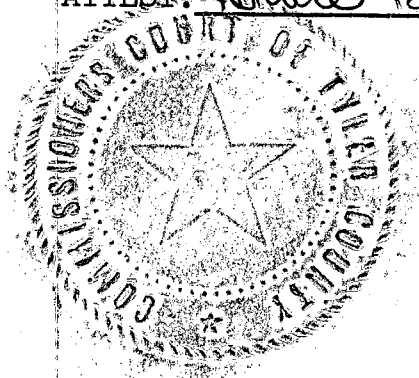


Gentlemen:

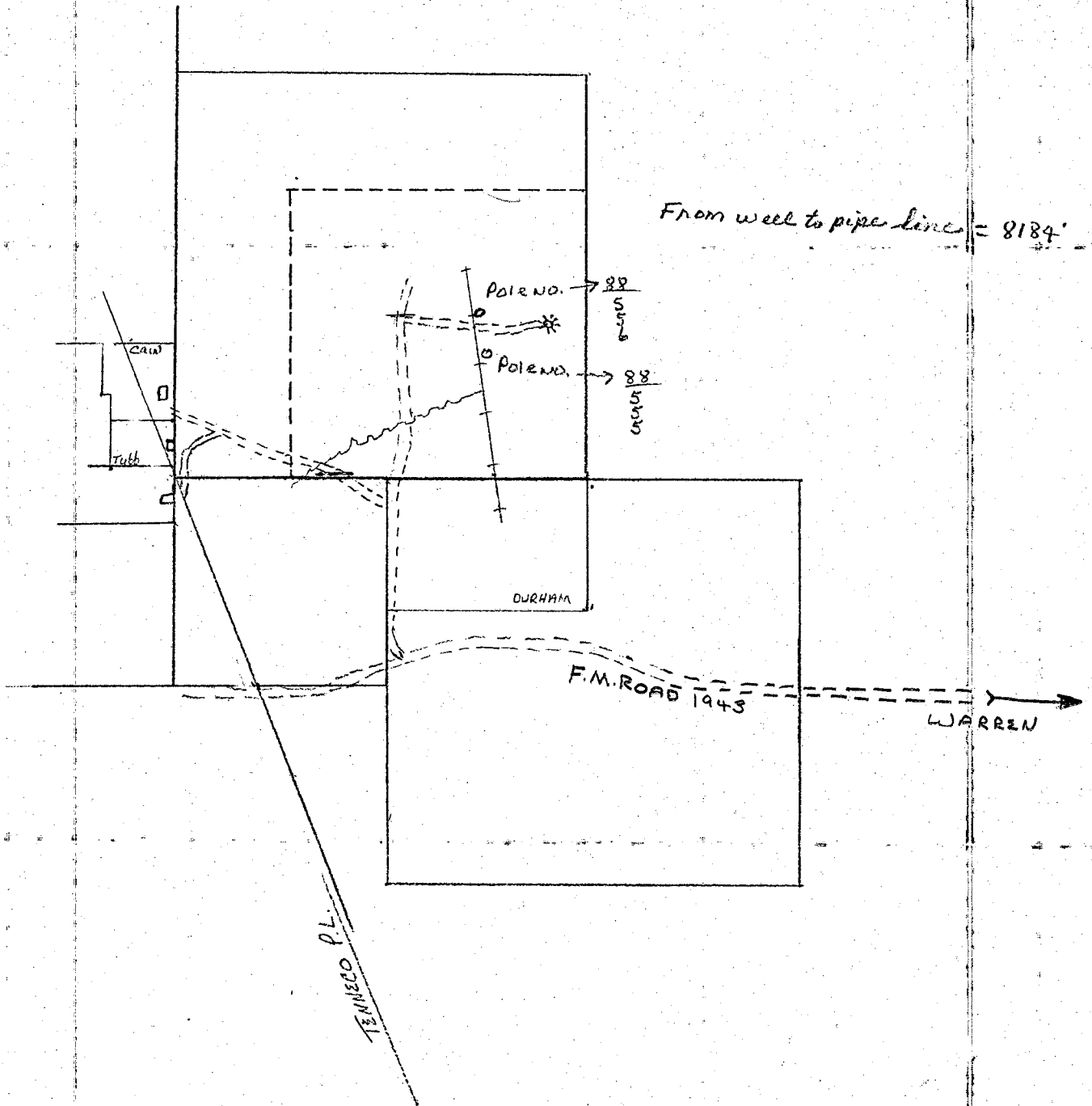

Gentlemen:

County

We have requested your permission to lay, maintain and operate along, across and under a public highway in Tyler County, Texas, a pipeline for the transportation of natural gas, such line to be constructed along the route as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

We understand and agree that all rights under such permit, when granted, shall be exercised only upon the following conditions:

1. All construction, maintenance and operation of such line shall be carried on in a manner that will in no way interfere with traffic on the road or highway at any time.
2. We will cause the road or highway to be promptly restored to its former condition of usefulness.
3. The restoration of the road or highway shall be subject also to the supervision of the Commissioners' Court or such other proper local authority as may be designated by the Commissioners' Court.
4. Wherever the pipeline is laid parallel with and on the highway right-of-way, such line shall not be closer than fifteen (15) feet from the improved section of the highway, except with the approval and under the direction of the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, Texas.
5. We agree to compensate the County of Tyler or the road district in which the pipeline is laid for any damage done to the public road in the exercise of the privileges conferred by such permit.
6. The pipeline shall at all points be buried thirty-six (36) inches below the present depth of the ditch.

7. If at any time it becomes necessary in the judgment of the Commissioners' Court to move or relocate the pipeline, we agree to pay all costs which may be incurred in the moving or relocation of the pipeline.

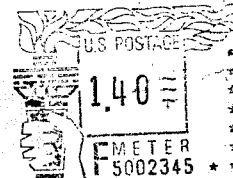
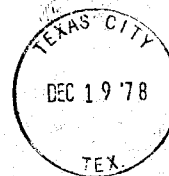

Dear Judge Sturrock:


We are in receipt of a request from Commissioner Maxie Riley, Precinct 1, for permission to enlarge his existing iron ore gravel pit on Kirby's property in the D. B. McComb Survey, Abstract 446, Tyler County, at the location pointed out to our representative and approximately as shown on the attached sketch, in red.

We hereby grant such permission subject to the following understanding:

1. The material removed hereunder will be used in maintenance of county roads in Precinct 1.
2. Removal will be confined to an area of approximately 1.50 of an acre and total quantities removed will not exceed 5000 cubic yards.
3. Timber within the pit site will be disposed of by Kirby Forest Industries, Inc.
4. Upon completion of the removals, the site will be left in condition that will drain freely and not hold water.

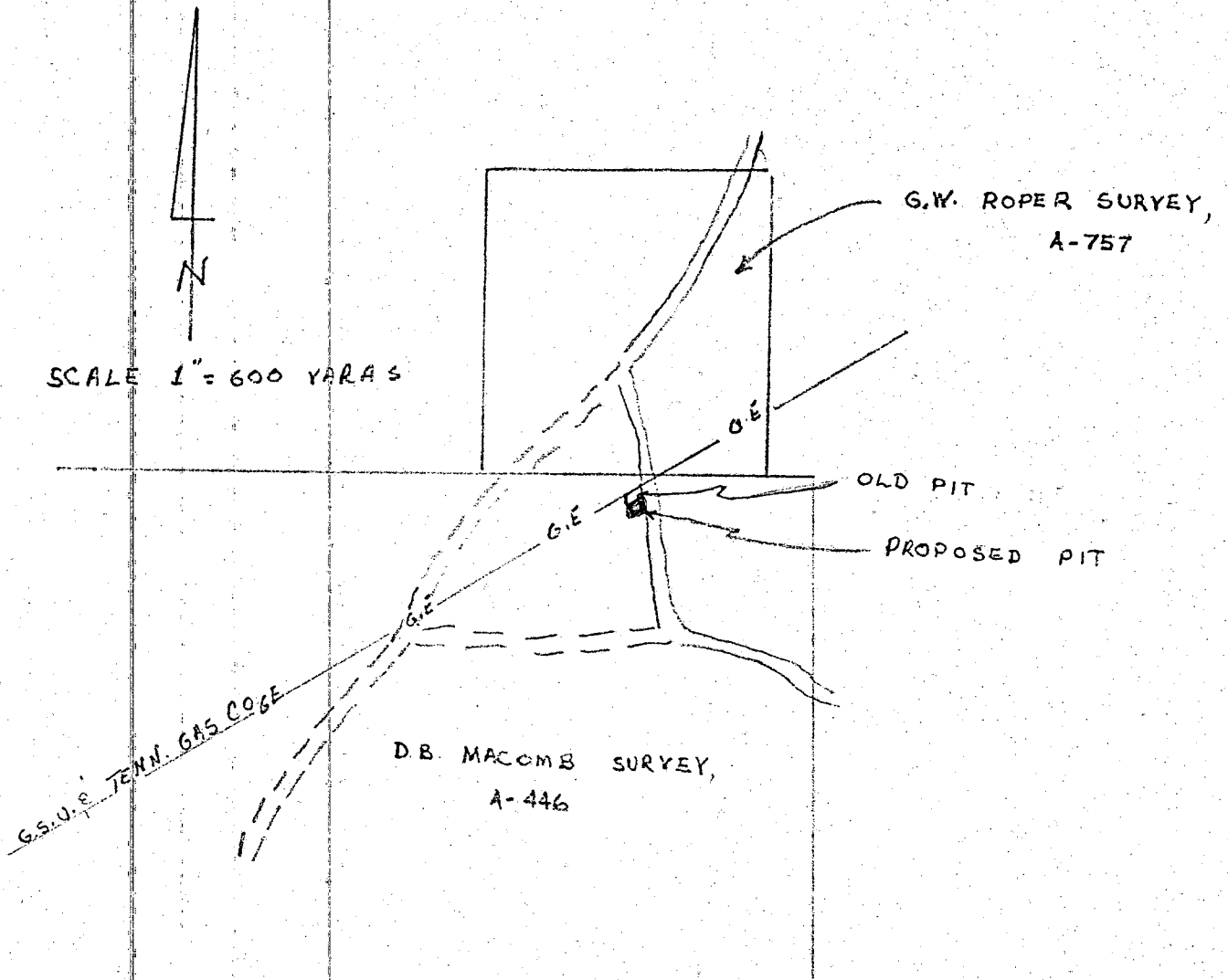

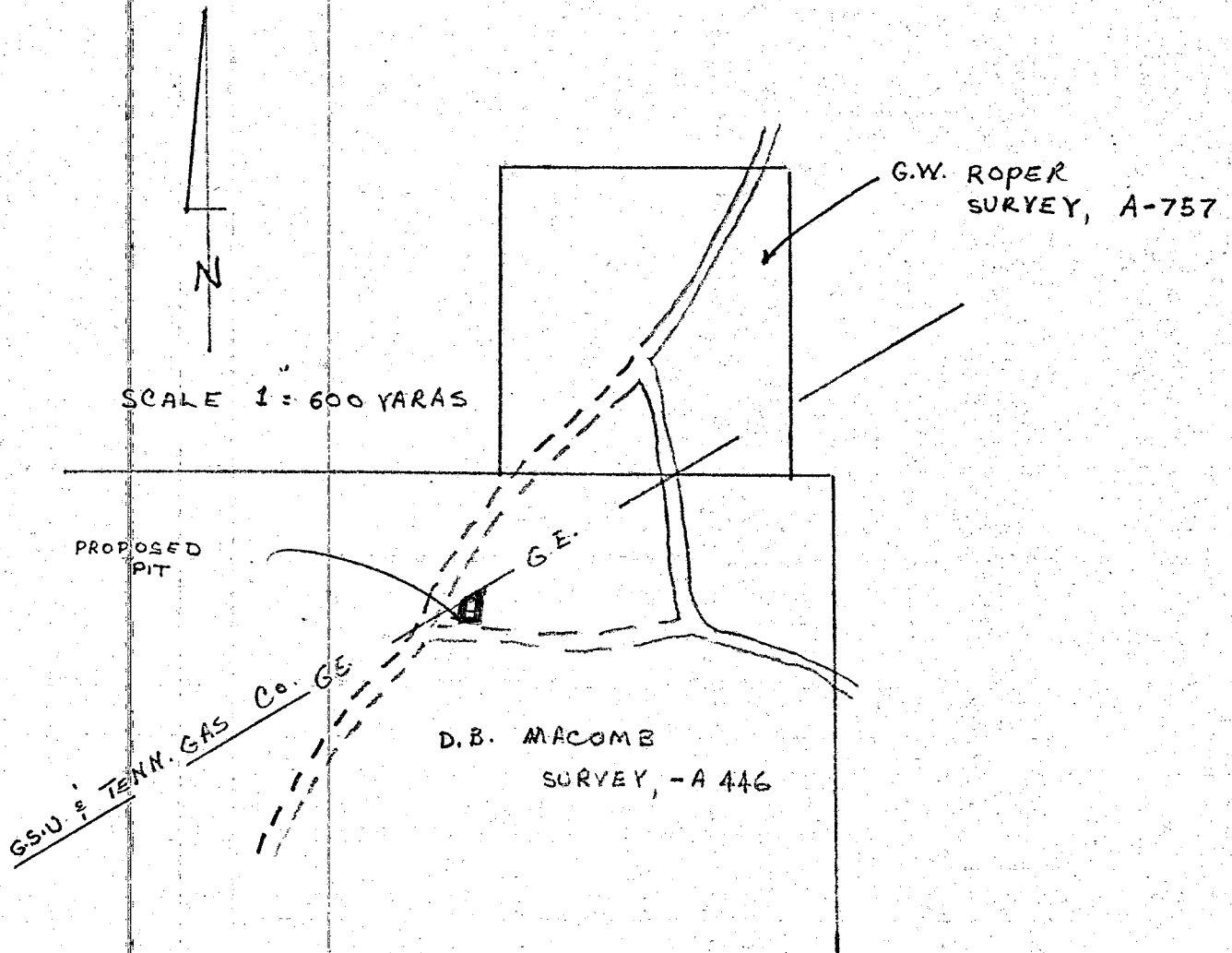


