EXECUTIVE SESSION-----OPEN

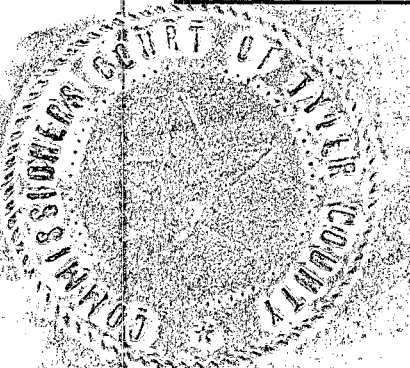

Our letter of January 5, 1979, advised you that limited Federal Funds were available for the replacement or rehabilitation of City and County Bridges that qualify under the transportation legislation passed by the last Congress.

We are now in position to proceed with the inventory, inspection and appraisal of these Off-System bridges and accordingly are furnishing herewith an "Agreement for the State to Survey, Inspect, Appraise and Inventory Bridges on Public Roads and Streets" which grants us permission to proceed with the on-site surveys and inspections of bridges under your jurisdiction.

Since we have been given the date of June 1, 1979, for completion of the Phase I portion of this inventory, we would appreciate your immediate execution of this agreement. After completion of the agreement by this office, one copy will be returned for your files.

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AGREEMENT FOR THE STATE TO SURVEY, INSPECT, APPRAISE  
AND INVENTORY BRIDGES ON PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS

THIS AGREEMENT, made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 19\_\_\_\_, by and between the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation, Party of the First Part, hereinafter called the "Department", and \_\_\_\_\_ County of Tyler \_\_\_\_\_, a local government, or governmental agency or entity, Party of the Second Part, acting by and through its \_\_\_\_\_ County Judge \_\_\_\_\_ and by virtue of the authority shown on Exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the Party of the Second Part is owner of certain bridges on public roads and streets within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Title 23, United States Code as amended by the Surface Transportation Act of 1978, requires that an inventory, inspection and appraisal be completed of all highway bridges on public roads and streets; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Department to assure accomplishment of this work.

A G R E E M E N T

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto to be by them respectively kept and performed, as hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

1. The Party of the Second Part hereby grants permission to the Department or its contracted Consultant, to perform on-site surveys and inspections of bridges under its jurisdiction for the purpose of developing inventory and appraisal information and data, and further agrees to furnish available information and data concerning such bridges, to the Department.

2. All of the above described information and data shall be the property of the Department. However, such information and data will be provided to the Party of the Second Part upon request.

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3. Nothing herein is intended to change the respective responsibilities under the laws of this State of the parties hereto. It is expressly understood that the Department's responsibility shall be limited to the reasonably prompt conveyance of information and data described in 2 above to the Party of the Second Part. Responsibility for deciding upon the imposition of load restriction, closure, repair or other such action, shall remain that of the Party of the Second Part.


