A Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Monday May 14, 1979 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Odom to Table the acceptance of the streets in the Haralson Subdivision, for further study. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Odom made a motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Fowler to have the Telephone reinstalled in the office of the Probation Department. The approval was given for County Treasurer Austin Fuller to be permitted to buy a desk and chair from Texas Surplus Property Agency, of Houston, Texas, for this office also. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to approve of paying the Monthly Bill, as submitted by County Auditor, Ann Fondren, with one amendment. Commissioner Riley amended the motion to request that foster parents, who are aided jointly by the County and welfare, seek approval for spending money on some items before making the purchase, rather than after. All voted yes and none no. See Bills attached.

Commissioner Fowler made the motion, which was seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve the County Treasurer's Monthly Report, as submitted by County Treasurer Austin Fuller. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe for County Attorney Rois L. Brockman, to preside for the Board of Equalization to take their Oath of Office. After this was done, then the Board set Monday June 11, 1979 as the next date for their regular meeting. All voted yes and none no. See Oath attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe for County Attorney Rois L. Brockman, to obtain a copy of the Rules and Regulations concerning County vehicles, and with a letter to the Grand Jury, be presented. This involves the use of County Vehicles for personal use. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
