TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT
REGULAR MEETING
AUGUST 13, 1979

The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday August 13, 1979 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to transfer the Pick-up Title from Solid Waste Fund to Road Prec. #1. The price of the Pick-up was \$700.00. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to appoint Mrs. L.E. (Joyce) Crowson, of Woodville to represent Tyler County on our Public Responsibility Committee. This is the Mental Health Mental Retardation Services. This is for a two-year term beginning on September 1, 1979. All voted yes and none no. See request attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to extend the time until Sept. 10, 1979 of Commissioners Regular Meeting, to open Bids on Bridges for Precincts III and IV. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to raise the Fee for paying the Jury duty to \$6.00, effective now. On January 1, 1980, it will be effective for the Grand Jury to be paid \$10.00 per day and those who are chosen to be active with the Jury, will receive \$10.00 per day. Those who do not serve, but do make an effort to come, will be paid \$6.00. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to advertise for Bids on cleaning and painting the Courthouse. These Bids will be seperate. Bids will be opened Sept. 10, 1979, at the Regular Meeting. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Riley to adopt the following Order: That the refund of \$28,193.70, to Tyler County, and upon receipt, will be used for Construction and Maintance of County Lateral Roads and Bridges. It is a request of the Commissioner's Court that these funds be returned to Tyler County. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom for the Court to pass a Resolution and name September as "Dog Vaccination Month" in Tyler County. The Commissioner's Court is encourageing all County residents to have their pets vaccinated and put vaccination collars, on the animals. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to appoint the following three citizens to serve on the Hospital Board: Mrs Odna Ogden, Colmesneil, Texas, Mr. Morris Clemmons, Woodville, Texas and Mr Johnny Harris, Warren, Texas. This is for a two year Term. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve the County Extension Monthly Report, as submitted to them. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Odom to approve the monthly report as submitted by County Treasurer, Austin Fuller. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.


