TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT  
 REGULAR MEETING  
 SEPTEMBER 10, 1979

The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday September 10, 1979, at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

Members from the Tyler County Fireman's Association, met with the Commissioner's Court. They discussed their need of help financially. A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom, to attempt to find money in the Budget, to help the Fireman, obtain the equipment in need. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to advertise Bids for a new car, for the Sheriff's Dept. There will be a Trade-in. Bids to be opened Sept. 21, 1979 at 10:00 A.M. See Specifications in the Sheriff's Office. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to correct the Minutes of Commissioner's Court, of August 13, 1979, to read, "Raise Fee for paying Jury Duty to \$6.00 effective on August 27" and for those active with the Jury, in the District Court, will receive \$10.00 per day, beginning January 1, 1980. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the County Treasurer's Report, for the month of August, as submitted by County Treas. Austin Fuller. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the monthly Report, as submitted by the County Extension Office. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to table the opening of Bids on the Bridges in Pct. III and IV. All voted yes and none no. This will be Sept. 21, 1979, at 10:00 A.M.

Commissioner Fowler made the motion which was seconded by Commissioner Odom, to table the opening of Bids on washing down the Courthouse and painting it, until Friday Sept. 14, 1979. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to approve Kathy Cruse as Deputy in the County Clerk's Office. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and approved by Commissioner Lowe to approve Bonds for Sharon Fuller and Louise Breaux in the District Clerk's Office. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to accept the Resolution of Deep East Texas County Commissioners and County Judges Association. All voted yes and none no. See copy attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to pay the Dues of \$100.00 to DETCOG. All voted yes and none no.

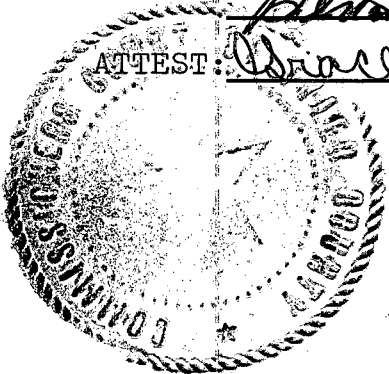
