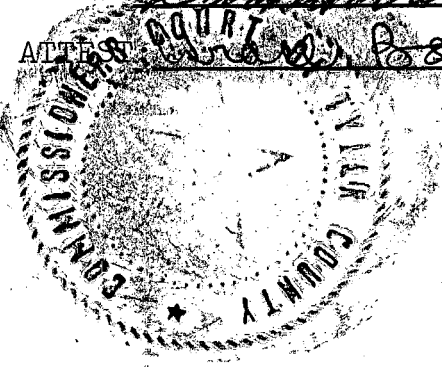



SUBJECT

Cleaning, waterproofing and coating all elevations from the ground up to top of building parapets or roof edge.

1. CLEANING

All surfaces to be treated will be cleaned with high pressure water through a special pump and gun to remove all dust, dirt and loose coatings. Surface shall be thoroughly rinsed after cleaning has been completed. The pump shall be capable of producing from 1,500 p.s.i. to 10,000 p.s.i.

2. SETTLEMENT CRACKS

All settlement cracks and joints showing signs of movement shall be cut out with power grinding machines to a depth of 3/8ths. inch, cleaned and primed with manufacturers recommended primer. The primer will be allowed to dry.

Deep cuts shall be packed to within 3/8ths, inch of the surface with closed cell backer rod a nominal size larger than the width of the cut. The cuts shall be caulked with Sonnyborn One Part Poly-sulfide, completely filling the joint. The surface of the sealant shall be tooled to match adjacent areas.

A select aggregate shall be broadcast into the sealant before it has set.

3. MASONRY-ARMOR TITE GROUT METHOD

All masonry in the described areas shall be waterproofed by the non-shrinking ARMOR TITE GROUT METHOD. The masonry shall be wet down and allowed to stand until dripping has ceased.

The masonry will then be given a heavy coat of non-shrinking ARMOR TITE in grout consistency, which shall be thoroughly scrubbed into the surface, filling all cracks, joints and openings.

The non-shrinking ARMOR TITE will be finished in a horizontal direction to produce a fine brush texture.

ADD CRETE ACRYLIC MIXING LIQUIDS shall be added to the non-shrinking ARMOR TITE at the hobsite, to replace one-third (1/3) of the mixing water.

ARMOR TITE and ADD CRETE ACRYLIC MIXING LIQUID are manufactured by Missouri Paint & Varnish Company.

4. OPENINGS

All window and door openings in the areas to be treated shall be caulked with PECORA ARCHITECTURAL GRADE CAULKING COMPOUND.

All loose materials shall be removed and deep openings filled with navy spun oakum tightly driven in. Surfaces to receive caulking shall be primed, and the caulking compound will then be placed with a hand gun in the form of a heavy triangular bead, engaging both the frame and the masonry to a distance of about one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) inch. The surface of the caulking to be tooled to a neat, smooth finish.

PECORA ARCHITECTURAL GRADE CAULKING COMPOUND is manufactured by Missouri Paint & Varnish Company.

5. COLOR CLAD GROUT

The surfaces will be given one (1) coat of COLOR CLAD GROUT, applied with large, stiff bristle brushes, scrubbing the grout into the surface at the rate of 125 sq. ft. per gallon.

Color to be selected by Owner.

COLOR CLAD GROUT is manufactured by Missouri Paint & Varnish Company.

6. WINDOW SASH PRIMING & PAINTING

Loose glazing will be removed. Surfaces will be scraped and wire brushed to remove loose, flaking, peeling paint.

All bare wood will be spot primed with ARMOR BRAND PRIMER.

Points and clips will be replaced as required, Glazing will be replaced with ARCHITECTURAL OIL BASE GLAZING COMPOUND.

One full finish coat of MPV OIL BASE PAINT will be applied to all sash and glazing. Color to match existing as closely as possible.

Woodville, Tex. 75979

- (1) Clean exterior of building to be free from Mildew, using a high pressure hydro washer to deliver at least 2600 psi and a solution of Tri sodium phosphate and clorox or equivalent.
- (2) Patch all cracks and voids in masonry to match existing with a recommended filler.
- (3) Reglaze windows where needed and paint to match existing walls.
- (4) Clock Tower: Spray or roll block filler, let dry 24 hours. Then spray with clear silicon water proofing.
- (5) Spray top ledge of building with silicon water proofing.
- (6) Paint all exterior surfaces with a top grade exterior acrylic latex.

- (1) Paint walls, trim and woodwork of hallways, corridors and stairs. Caulk all cracks, and sand woodwork smooth. Paint walls with a top grade washable Latex. Paint all trim with a top grade Oil Base Enamel.

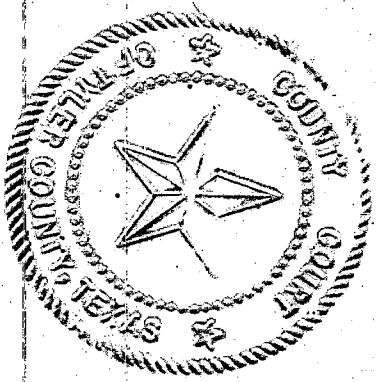
