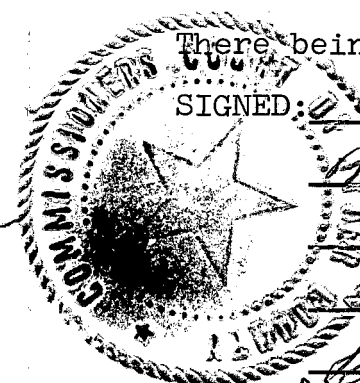



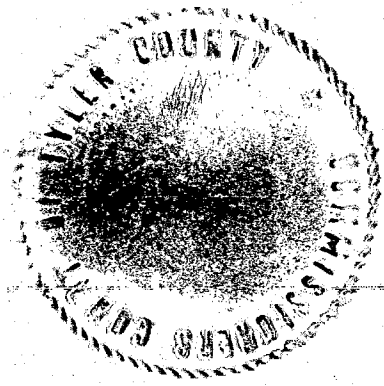

in accordance with the laws and statutes of the State of Texas and in the

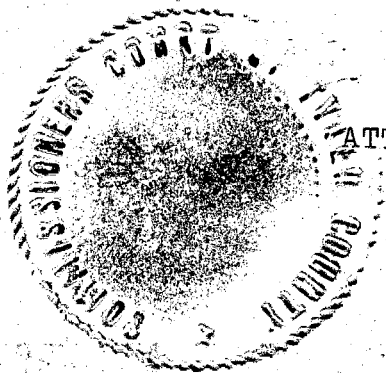
