A report is expected February 28, 1980, during a Commissioners Court Meeting. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve paying of monthly Bills, as submitted by the County Auditor, Ann Fondren. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to amend the Road and Bridge Budget, for Pct. #II. All voted yes and none no. See attached copy.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the amending of the Budget for Historical Society until the March Regular Term of Commissioners Court, which is March 10, 1980. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the Bid of Lufkin Typewriter, and Cash Register Co. for the Royal 990 electric Typewriter, for the Office of the County Clerk. The price of \$780.30. All voted yes and none no. See Bids attached.

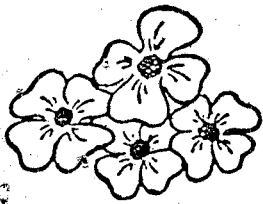

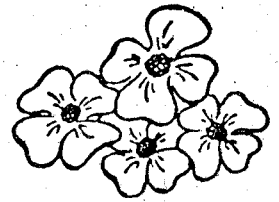
There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.


