A Special Meeting of Commissioner's Court, met on Friday February 29, 1980 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present, except Commissioner Fowler. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to accept the Map of Tyler County Water Supply Corp., and Atty. Josiah Wheat will keep this in his possession. The approval of Permit Application was signed and is attached. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the resignation of the Tyler County Veteran Service Officer, Mr. E.M. Pitts. This will be effective March 31, 1980. All voted yes and none no. See attached resignation.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to fill the vacancy of Election Judge and Alternate for Voting Box 11, in Pct. #3. Mr. J.C. Dickerson as Election Judge and Mr. Cecil Dubose as Alternate Judge. All voted yes and none no.

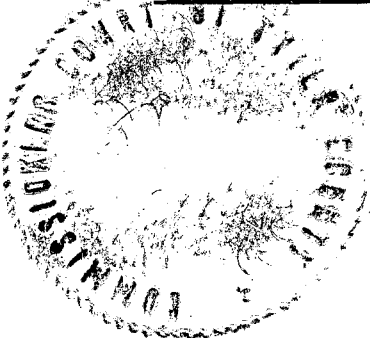
A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the appointment of a Tyler County Veteran Service Officer, until Monday March 3, 1980 at 9:00 A.M. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Odom to comply with requirements for Handicapped people entering and transacting business in the Courthouse. The details would include a small ramp at the entrance of the front door, another ramp in the hall, on the steps, which lead to each rest room, that is equipped for Wheelchairs, and then a ramp at the street entrance on the west side of the Courthouse. This parking place will be reserved for the Handicapped. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to authorize Architect Don Cole, to do drawings and specifications for the Elevator for the Courthouse. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
