Re: Federal Revenue Sharing Budget Amendment

Gentlemen:

The attached budget amendment is being done to better_utilize funds. According to the Estimated Allocation Statement received, (see attached copy), during the later part of 1979, Tyler County's estimated allocation was increased from \$147,908.00_to \$189,212.00. This increase is due to adjusted taxes and inter-governmental transfer increases. The previous years statement is shown also, for comparison purposes.

Amendment 1: Allen Shivers Library. This amendment was approved previously but is being included in this report for record only. It was requested for increases in Library personnel salary.

Amendment 2: Independent Audit. Revenue Sharing regulations require independent audits every three years. Our last audit was in 1977 and it will be necessary to have another audit of the 1980 funds. Since a portion of the audit will be done in 1981, the full cost of the audit need not be included in the 1980 budget. Additional funds of approximately \$6,000.00 should be included in the next budget.

Amendment 3: Tyler County Mental & Physical Clinic. According to my information, sufficient funds have been raised for the clinic without the need of the Countys.

Amendment 4: Tyler County Airport. According to Maxie Riley, manager of the Airport, some funds are needed to complete the building on the airport grounds, which will be utilized as a rest-stop for pilots. This building can also be used for community meetings as well.

Amendment 5: Data Processing System. This includes the necessary funds needed to upgrade the current accounting system in the Auditor's office for the current year.

Road & Bridge Amendments: Balance of funds, approximately \$40,000.00 to be distributed to the precincts by the percentage basis. I recommend this distribution because the Lateral Road funds, vetoed by the legislature, were divided in this manner. These excess funds will replace the Lateral Road funds which were originally funded in their respective accounts.
