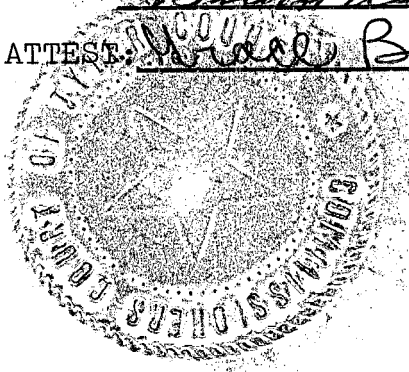
RECESS FOR 15 MINUTES
