A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table the request for mobile radio assistance from the Tyler County Ambulance Service. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the request of Lum Butler on Scholarship Fund, (T.C.M.O.) because of being unable to use Tax money for such purposes. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to approve the County Treasurer's monthly report as presented by County Treasurer Austin Fuller. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

Commissioner Fowler made the motion which was seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the monthly reports as presented by County Extension Agent, Clinton Currie. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve R.A. Jernigan as Independent Public Weigher. Bond and Oath are attached. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to approve and accept the R.O. Wein E.L. Jennings Survey, Abst. No. 405. This is a 40' road. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to convey a strip of land, adjoining the Tyler County Hospital, to the Tyler County Hospital, from Tyler County. This is for future use by the Hospital, with stipulations that this property will never be sold, but will convert back to the County, if ownership changes. All voted yes and none no. A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Riley giving permission for District and County Clerks to attend Annual Conference in Brownsville, June 17-20, 1980. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Fowler to prepare the 1981 Budget for replacing Radars for Highway Patrol. All voted yes and none no.

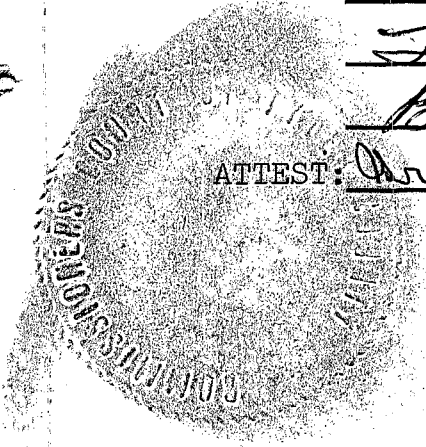

Field note description of a forty (40') foot road in the E. L. BEGINNING at a point for corner in the center of said 40' road on the East line of a County Maintained dirt road known as the "Spring Valley Road", said point also being North 32 deg. 15' 46" West from a 2" galvanized iron pipe set for the Northwest corner of a 0.399 acre tract and being Tract No. 1 and South 32 deg. 15' 46" East from the Southwest corner of a 0.378 tract and being Tract No. 12 of the Jim V. Mahan lots;
