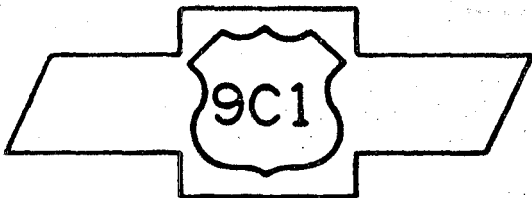

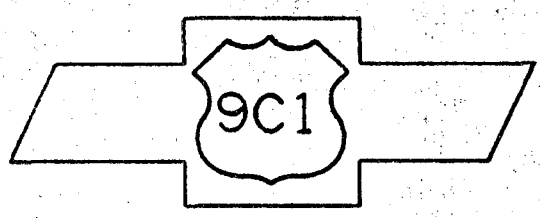

BRAKE PERFORMANCE

The brake performance test consisted of four W.O.T. accelerations to a minimum of 90 mph with an immediate decel to 0 mph at a minimum rate of 22 ft/sec² - a W.O.T. acceleration to a minimum of 60 mph with an impending skid, maximum decel rate to 0 mph - a five minute hot soak at idle - a repeat of the four 90 mph stops - a repeat of the 60 mph max. decel stop - followed immediately (no five minute hot soak), by another W.O.T. acceleration to a minimum of 60 mph with a four wheel lock up stop from 60 to 0 mph.

The test was considered successful based on the following criteria:

- The minimum speeds were attained prior to braking.
- A minimum of 22 ft/sec² was maintained during the 90 to 0 mph stops.
- All four wheels locked in final 60 to 0 mph stop.
- The vehicle stopped in a straight line in final 60 to 0 mph stop.
- The vehicle stopped within a 12 ft. lane in final 60 to 0 mph stop.
- There was not significant brake fade during the test.
