County Judge Allen Sturrock, presented a letter of resignation from the Justice of Peace, Frank S. Grimes, Pct. #III, to the Court. Mr. Grimes was not present. A motion was made by Commissioner Fowler and seconded by Commissioner Riley to accept the resignation of J.P. Pct. #III, Frank S. Grimes. All voted yes and none no. See attached letter.

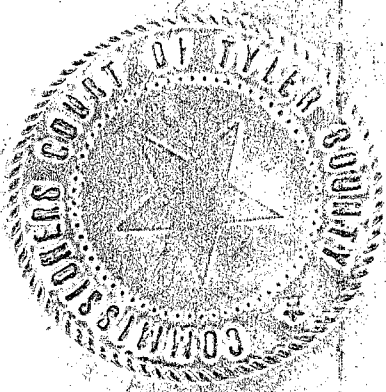
A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table the paying of Bills, for the month of August, 1980, until Sept. 26, 1980 at 3:00 P.M.. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table the discussion of plans and specifications for the Elevator until Friday Sept. 26, 1980 at 3:00 P.M. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to set the Tax Rate for Tyler County Taxpayers of \$1.35 per \$100.00 value. The new tax rate breaks down as follows: .30 County Special fund; .80 for General Fund, and .15 for Hospital Fund, and .10 for Road and Bridge Fund. A total of \$1.35. The County will retain its 35 per cent assessment ratio. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

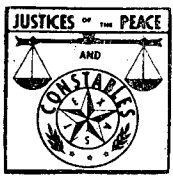
Gentlemen -

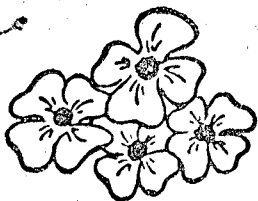

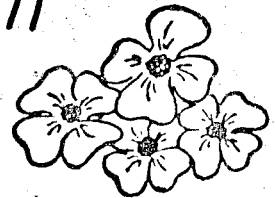

Gentlemen:

With reference to the discrepancy in the account of Frank Grimes, Justice-of-Peace, Pct. III, I feel it is my duty at this time, to give you an itemized account of the missing funds.

On July 30, 1980, I had the records of Frank Grimes in my possession. They were subpoenaed by the Texas Judicial Conduct Commission. As of this date, they still have the books and my records, so an itemized account cannot be made until the books are returned. A rough estimate of proven shortages would be between \$300 and \$400. The original shortage reported to you almost a year ago was \$800, which included some fines which have been reported to the county but were withheld at least a year.

I am asking that the final checks due Frank Grimes be withheld pending a detailed account of the shortage per Article 3912e, Section 7 V.C.S., which reads:

"No warrant shall be drawn on said fund or funds in favor of any person indebted to the State, county or to said fund or in favor of his agent or assignee until such debt is paid."


