A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Friday, March 13, 1981 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

Mr. Joe Weeks gave a presentation of his Recordings.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Odom to accept the highest Bid, for the car, from the Sheriff's Dept., from L.E. (Buddy) Greenwood, for the price of \$525.00. All voted yes and none no. See Bids attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to place, "Folger" the Drug Dog, on the Tyler County Sheriff's Inventory, at the value of \$4500.00. It will be permissible for this dog, with a trainer from Tyler County, to be used in other counties. If the dog is killed, then this value fee is paid to Tyler County. The fee for using the dog will be decided by the Sheriff. All voted yes and none no. As to where the dog will be located or who will have charge of him will be decided later.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Odom to give J.P. Judge John Spanhanks, the authority to have the Courthouse exterminated for Roaches, on a one-time basis. Judge Spanhanks said that he believed this would be the best way to rid the roaches. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to accept the Bid of Bill West, Rt. 1 Box 548, Jasper, Texas, on the chainlink fence for Pct. #III, County Barn. The accepted bid was \$5800.00. Two bids were presented. All voted yes and none no. See Bids attached. This cost will be paid for, from Revenue-sharing fund.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to reject any and all Bids on the Tilt Trailer for Pct. #III. All voted yes and none no. See Bids attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to table the consideration of County Atty. Joe Smith, on a six man Jury Box for County Court. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to approve of paying bills for the County, as submitted by the County Auditor, Ann Fondren. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to accept a Budget Revision, for the District Attorneys Office. All voted yes and none no. See attached amendment.

The Commissioners discussed a resolution, asking the legislature to raise the salary that can be payed to Juvenile Judges. It was decided, by Commissioner Riley making the motion which was seconded by Commissioner Mahan, not to send the Resolution. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to table the discussion from Don Cole. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

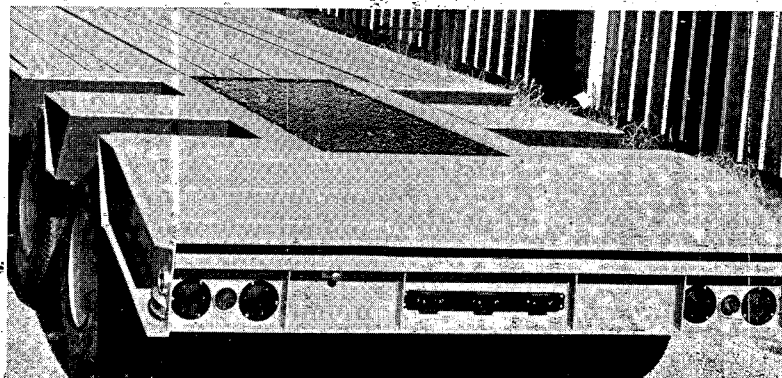
