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A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Friday, May 15, 1981 at 10:00 A.M. All members were present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Treasurer, Austin Fuller.

Melinda Stryker presented the County Judge and Commissioners with a Certificate of Appreciation from the Texas Department of Human Resources. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley to authorize Melinda Stryker to contact and select a person in California Human Resources to administer funds to the foster children now residing in California and account to the Court for the expenditure of funds. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lowe. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to pay the outstanding bill of \$20.00 to Dr. John Gilchrist. The bill was submitted by Melinda Stryker. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Mahan made a motion to appoint Ann McInnis and Margaret McNeal to the Child Welfare Board. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Riley. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to recognize Mrs. Hazel Jackson with a resolution of appreciation for her outstanding work with foster children. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Mahan made a motion to approve payment of the outstanding bills as submitted by the County Auditor. This is to include the Court Reporter bill of \$ 175.00 from McLennan County. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Odom. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to enter in an agreement with DETCOG for a contract for them to do work involved in the mandatory redistricting of the county. The contract will be signed by County Judge. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Odom. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan to amend the budget for Precinct III moving money originally in fuel. \$4000.00 will be put into Asphalt, \$5000.00 into Culverts and \$9000.00 into Contract Labor. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lowe. The amended budget will be filed May 29, 1981. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to go out for bids on a new pickup truck for Precinct III with a second bid on a used truck. The bids will be opened June 8, 1981. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Mahan made a motion to Table the resignation of Veterans Officer, Paul E. Walker. Commissioner Lowe seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to go out for bids on a Front End Loader for Precinct II with a trade-in of a 450 John Deere Loader. The trade-in can be seen at the Prect. II barn. Bids will be opened June 8, 1981 and will be paid with time warrants. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to put in a two-line phone system with a hold button in the County Clerk's Office. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

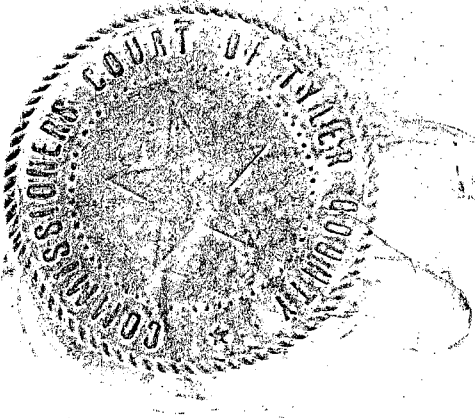

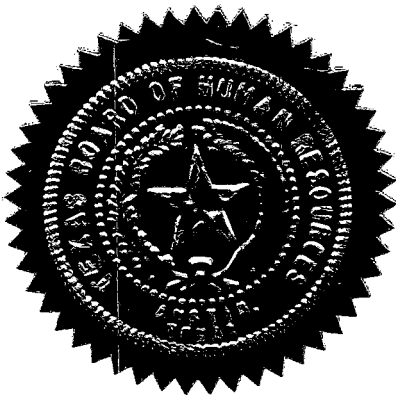

The Deep East Texas Council of Governments, herein referred to as "DETCOG", agrees to provide to Tyler County the following timely services:

- (1) To provide Tyler County with a detailed statement of the redistricting requirements of Federal, State, and Local law with respect to the following:
 - (a) County Commissioner's Precinct
 - (b) County Voting Precinct
- (2) To provide to the Commissioner's Court a schedule of the population changes in each precinct and the implication of such changes in regard to redistricting.
- (3) To provide to the Commissioner's Court recommendations and alternatives on the restructuring of precinct lines consistent with population changes and requirements of Federal, State, and Local law.
- (4) To publish Seventy-five (75) copies of the recommendations and their alternatives in a manner so as to allow sufficient time for informed public comment at the public hearings.
- (5) To conduct at least two (2) public hearings with adequate notice through media coverage to the citizenry in order to allow for public comment on the recommendations.
- (6) To prepare maps identifying population changes from 1970 to 1980 in existing voting precincts, county precincts, and physical descriptions by census enumeration district.
- (7) To prepare proposed REDISTRICTING MAP and PLAN with a physical description of the boundaries, population, and electorate data, including the plan's methodology for adoption by the County Commissioner's Court.
- (8) To present the Adopted Redistricting Plan to the United States Justice Department, Secretary of State's Office, State of Texas and other agencies as required by law.

Time of Completion

1. The DETCOG shall complete the plans and specifications herein established within one hundred (100) working days after the execution of this contract.

Compensation


2. The County shall compensate DETCOG for the above services by the payment of the following fee:

The direct and indirect cost of professional services, DETCOG staff services, travel, printing and publishing expenses, plus twelve percent (12%) of the total direct and indirect cost, not to exceed \$10,000.

The fee shall be due and payable on the completion of the plans and specifications, and their approval by the Tyler County Commissioner's Court.


SPECIAL ACTION TAKEN THIS MONTH:

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
