A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner to table improvements on 92 R.O.W. All voted yes and none no.

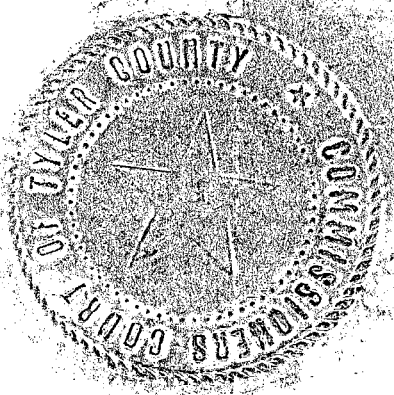
