SPECIAL MEETING
AUGUST 14, 1981

A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Friday August 14, 1981 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to amend the paying of Bills, as submitted by County Auditor, by adding a bill for Foster Child Care, Brookshire Bros., Fairway Foods and land purchased from Helen F. Buckles. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to accept the Bid of Lanier Business Prod., Inc. for Dictating Equipment for the Office of the County Atty. The cost is \$972.00 Bid attached. All voted yes and none no. There was only one Bid.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to amend the Budget of 1981. This motion was passed by all Commissioners except Commissioner Mahan. This amendment will allow a total of \$50,000.00 to be retained in the General Road & Bridge Fund. All Fines thereafter to be deposited in General Fund. Budget Amendment attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to permit the Tyler County Fair, to move 50 feet of fencing, bordering the County Airport. The fence will be moved back off the road to permit more space for the Fair's Carnival Rides. The Fair Committee will provide labor for the job, and split the cost of materials with the County. Total expenditure for the County will be approximately \$230.00 All voted yes and none no.

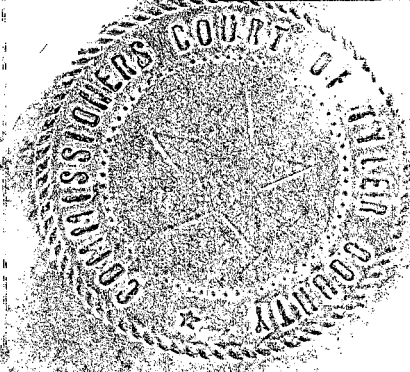
Organize Re-districting
