Dear Sir:

On or before October 15, 1981, we will be sending to your County Treasurer the pro rata portion of the Lateral Road funds for your county. The distribution in October will actually represent three years accumulation of funds for fiscal years 1980, 1981, and 1982. Additionally, the interest earned on these funds during fiscal years 1980 and 1981 will be distributed. At this date, the exact amount to be distributed to your county cannot be determined, as the distribution will include interest that will not be credited until September of this year.

For your planning purposes, the amount to be distributed to each county this year will be approximately three times the amount distributed in September of 1979, the latest distribution. The reason for this larger distribution is to make up for 1980, which was missed, plus a provision in the law to make the entire funds available at the <u>beginning</u> of the fiscal year.

As in the past, these funds are to be used for the construction and improvement of your county's lateral roads. Before we can send the funds to you, the statute requires that we receive a report from you detailing how the funds previously provided were used. You are to use the enclosed form entitled "County Lateral Road Account" for this purpose. This report may cover two years if you had carry-forward funds from the 1979 distribution. This report must be received by the State Treasurer on or before October 1, 1981.

I am very pleased, as I know you are, that this legislation was enacted. My close association with the counties for so many years has made me appreciate the needs of the counties. If at any time I may be of assistance to you, please do not hesitate to call on me.
