REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 12, 1981

The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday October 12, 1981 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Treasurer Austin Fuller.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the County Treasurer's Monthly Report, as he presented it. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to approve the monthly report from the County Extension Office as presented by Mr. Currie. All voted yes and none no.

Speaking in opposition to the redistricting alternative recommended to the Court, by the Tyler County Re-districting Committee was Elizabeth Julian, an Attorney for East Texas Legal Services. Julian told the Court, that she represented the Tyler County Minority Outreach Organization, and the Woodville branch of the NAACP. After a lengthy discussion came to a conclusion, the Commissioners voted to adopt the re-districting boundaries, recommended by the Re-districting Committee. A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to adopt these boundaries, for Tyler County. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table voting box lines, until October 19, 1981. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the appointment of Voting Chairman for Pct. 18, until October 19, 1981. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Lowe made a motion to adopt the tax rate as requested, with Commissioner Mahan voting no. Two other Commissioners not voting. Then Commissioner Riley made the motion to decrease the rate 1 cent. The motion died for a lack of a second.

RECESS 5 MINUTES-----IN SESSION

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to adopt the Tax Rate of 48.5. This gave an increase of 15.48 percent. Commissioners Lowe, Riley and Odom voted with approval, while Commissioner Mahan voted against the increase.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table the Bids on Portable Building for Pct. #III, until October 19, 1981. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the opening of Bids on the sale of CB Radios from Pct. #III, until Oct. 19, 1981. All voted yes and none no. Bid attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to reject the Bids on a Pickup which Commissioner Mahan in Pct. #III had for sale. All voted yes and none no. Bid attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Lowe authorizing the County Clerk to solicit bids for a Typewriter for the Clerk's Office. All voted yes and none no. Bids to be opened Oct. 19, 1981.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to elect Commissioner Jerry Mahan to replace Jerry Grimes as the County Court's representative to the Tyler County Tax Appraisal Board. A resolution was passed to commend Mr. Grimes for the good service that he had rendered on the Appraisal Board. All voted yes and none no.

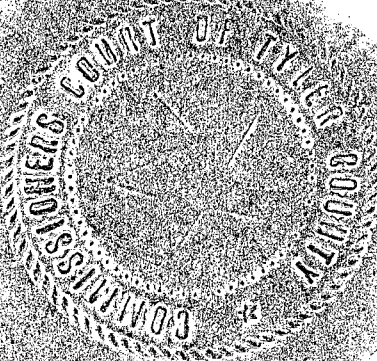
