The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday January 11, 1982 at 10:00'Clock. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the County Treasurer's monthly report, with two amendments from Pct. #2 and transfer the amount of \$11.81 from the General Fund to the Airport Fund, to complete a bill of this amount payable from the Airport Fund. All voted yes and none no. Report attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the Report from the office of the County Extension. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to set terms for County Court, by listing January, April, July and October as dates for 1982. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to set Holidays for 1982, for Tyler County Court employees as listed on attachment. All voted yes and none no.

The Grievance Committee for Tyler County consists of six elected officials, and three chosen from the Grand Jury list of 1981. The following three were chosen, with three alternates. (1) James Johnson, Box 1015 Dogwood Rural Station, Woodville, Texas 75979. (2) Tommy Cubley, Rt. 1 Box 103 Colmesneil, Texas 75938. (3) Willie Gill, St. Rt. 1 Box 169 Woodville, Texas 75979. Alternates: (1) A.J. Spurlock, Rt. 1 Box 8-A, Fred, Texas 77616. Polly Barlow, Rt. 1 Doucette, Texas 75942. (2) and Mickey Richardson, Rt. 1 Box 220-I Colmesneil, Texas 75938. (3). All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to select Tax-assessor Collector Barbara Tolbert as a member to Tax Appraisal Board of Review. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to give County Auditor Ann Nichol, permission to attend a Computer Training Seminar. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to pay under protest, the first installment on Tax Appraisal District. Three Commissioner's voted yes, with Commissioner Odom voting 'No'

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to adopt a Resolution, for all County Officials to be paid on a Salary Basis for 1982. All voted yes and none no. Copy of letter to Honorable Bob Bullock, Comptroller of Public Accounts, Austin, Texas 78774 attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to give County Judge Allen Sturrock permission to evaluate the space usage in the Courthouse, and the Commissioners were assigned to Courthouse duties, with Commissioner Riley in charge of the Tyler County Airport, Commissioner Lowe, garbage dump, Commissioner Odom and Commissioner Mahan, in charge of the County Jail. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the Bids on Sheriff's car, until Friday. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to amend the Budget so that Tyler County Sheriff Fowler could be helped in meeting expense, for his Department. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was also mde by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom for the Sheriff's Dept. to buy a breathing device necessary to maintain accreditation of the jail. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe for the County Attorney to file suit for non payment on Cancer Policy, of a former County employee. All voted yes and none no.

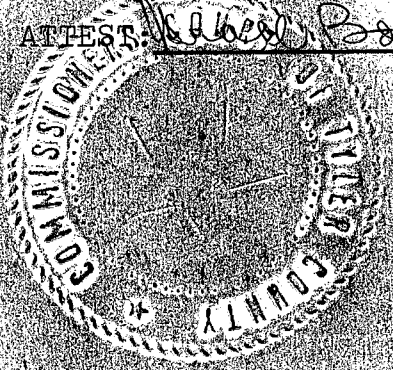

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to table the filling vacancies of Election Judges, until Friday; Then a motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Odom to untable this motion and appoint John Yearwood as Election Judge for voting Box 18 in Precinct 2. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan for County Judge Allen Sturrock, to appoint a committee and work toward the available space in the Court-house. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
