The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday, February 8, 1982 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock. VOL 007 PAGE 47

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to accept the report of County Treasurer, Austin Fuller. This is the monthly report, attached. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the monthly report, from the County Extension Office. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to join the Regional Housing Finance Corporation and sign a Resolution when it is presented to the Court, with no cost to the County. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom for District Clerk, Pat Brown, to advertise for Bids on a Typewriter for her Office. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to adopt a resolution to begin preparation on maps of the County to be updated, indicating which roads in the precincts are County Roads. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to notify all area commercial haulers, of Garbage, to meet with the Commissioners Court, next Friday, at 10:00 A.M., Feb. 12, 1982. A decision is expected on Fees, for Garbage Haulers. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to study and Table the renewing lease with Chem-Air for one year. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to solicit Bids for Pct. IV, on a Welding Machine. Bids to be opened Friday Feb. 12, 1982. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to approve of the Insurance for the Courthouse, as submitted by Morris Clemmons, Insurance. There will be an additional 7% increase and also the additional on the Elevator. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

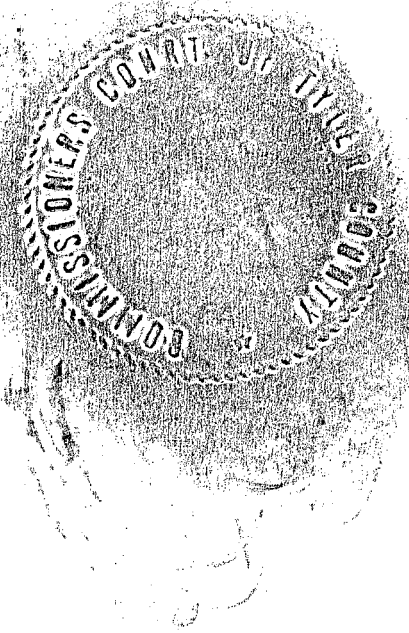

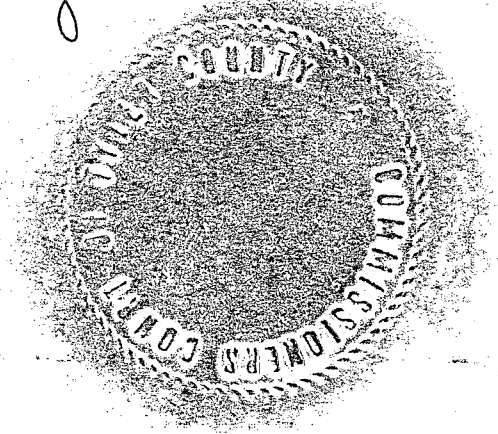


