A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to solicit bids, for Tax-assessor Collectors Office, for a Typewriter and Caculator. Bids to be opened June 14, 1982. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to approve the County Auditors Annual Report, from Auditor Ann Nichol. All voted yes and none no. See attached.
