The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday July 12, 1982 at 10:00 A.M. Two members, Commissioners, Lowe and Riley were present, with two members, Commissioners, Odom and Mahan being absent. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Treasurer Austin Fuller.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the County Treasurers monthly report as presented. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the monthly report from the County Extension Office, as presented. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to appoint J.B. (Toby) Spurlock, for a two year term on the Tyler County Hospital Board. All voted yes and none no. A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to appoint W.E. (Bill) Brown to also serve a two year term. A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to appoint Mr. Carl Fairchild as Honorary Member of the Board. All voted yes and none no. All of these members have served prior to this appointment. The third vacant position will be filled next Friday July 16, 1982, at a Special Meeting.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to extend the bidding of a car for the Sherriff's Dept. for thirty days, to allow time for more bids to come in, since there was only one. This one was not opened. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to appoint County Judge Allen Sturrock, as its representative to the Deep East Texas Mental Health Retardation Board for a two (2) year term. All voted yes and none no. See copy attached.

Since Mr. Jess Collins was not present to represent the system of numbering or naming County Roads, a motion was made to table this until Friday July 16, 1982. All voted yes and none no. Motion by Comm. Lowe and seconded by Comm. Riley.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the consideration of purchasing land from International Paper Co., for a dump site, until Friday July 16, 1982. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to not accept a subdivision Plat, for Pct. #2, because the roads are not up to County standards. As the roads meet the County requirements, then the Plat may be accepted. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to table the request for bids on Fuel for the County, until Friday July 16, 1982. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to accept the report from the Probation Dept., for the month of June, as presented. All voted yes and none no. See copy attached.

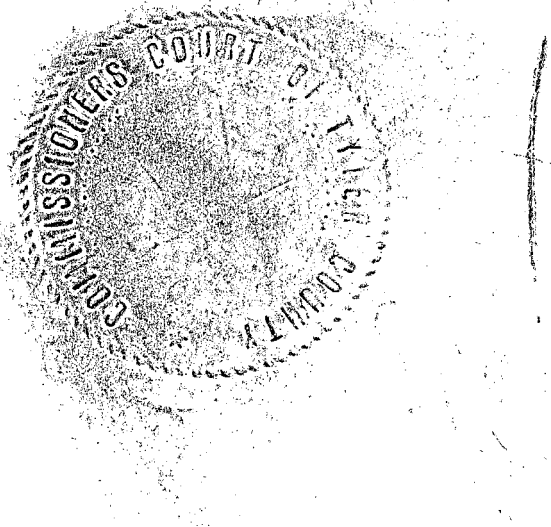
A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to amend the Budget for Pct. #2. All voted yes and none no. See attached.
