A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Friday July 16, 1982 at 10:00 A.M. All mebers being present except Commissioner Odom. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the monthly bills, as submitted by County Auditor, Ann Nichol. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to table the amending budget for Pct. #1 until the regular meeting in August. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to appoint J. Robert Barnes of Chester, as a member to the Tyler County Hospital Board. All voted yes and none no. He will serve a two year term.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to pass a Resolution to purchase 40 acres of land, from International Paper Co., which is now occupied by Tyler County Sanitary Land Fill. This purchase price is \$28,000.00. This will be completed, pending the preparation of the deed by County Attorney, Joe Smith. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to advertise for Bids, for the County, on Oil, Gasoline, and Diesel. Bids to be opened at regular meeting in August. All voted yes and none no. Specifications attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the contract with DETCOG for Pre-application of HUD GRANT. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to advertise for Bids on a Trailer for Pct. #II. Bids to be opened August. 9, 1982. All voted yes and none no. See specifications attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to appoint Election Judges for any vacancies, and to re-affirm those who have been serveing as Judges. All voted yes and none no. A list is attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to table the voteing Box #18 and also all boxes for Commissioner Pct. #4. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to advertise for Bids, on Carpet for the County Clerk's Office. Bids to be opened Aug. 9, 1982 All voted yes and none no. Spec. attached.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

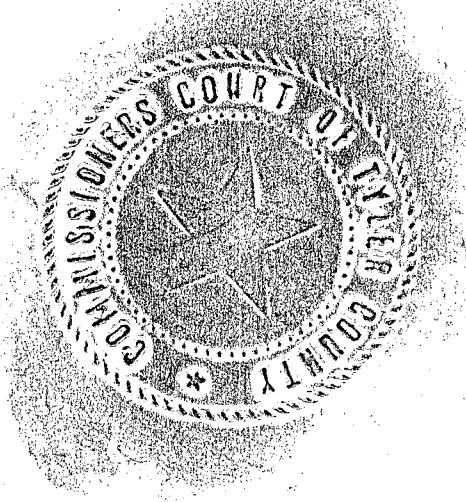

The cost of providing the technical and administrative services described above is Two Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$225.00).


