A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the County Treasurer's monthly report, as submitted by Mr. Fuller. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the paying of Bills, as submitted by Auditor Ann Nichol. A check for \$1000.00 from H.G. Sutton was accepted by Commissioner Mahan for the County Roads. All voted yes and none no. See bills attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to adopt a Resolution to stay with the existing original R O W plans for Highway 92 South. The Highway Dept. will make an effort to identify the land corners. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to appoint the following for alternates for Election Judges, for the County. Mr. Joe Cash voting Box #2, Mrs Roxann Babin, for voting Box #18. and Mr. for voting Box #3. All voted yes and none no.

Said permit is being rejected because it was not obtained through the legal process as required by the laws of the State of Texas as set out in Vernon's Civil Annotated Statutes.

FURTHERMORE, Tyler County rejects and will not accept any liabilities or authority for the maintenance or control of any dam site or spillway of any nature concerning the impoundment known as Lake Hyatt;

THAT Tyler County's responsibility and ownership goes only to the road surface for the maintenance of said road surface;

THAT said road surface as dedicated and accepted by the Commissioner's Court, the County does not own the dam site, the ground the dam is on, nor the spillway;

THAT Tyler County only accepted the surface of said roads in Lake Hyatt Subdivision;

THAT all lands below said surface are in record title of the developer, H.K. Maxey..





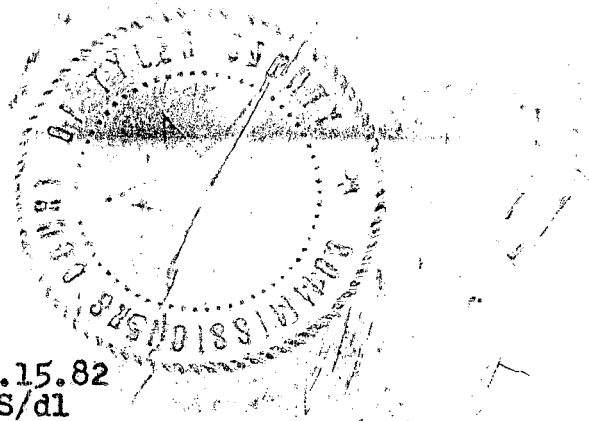

A resolution by the County Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas to:

Authorize filing of a Community Development Block Grant Application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and related actions.

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners Court of Tyler County, Texas, desire the viable development of those areas within its' jurisdiction, including housing, a suitable living environment and expanding economic development opportunities for all of the the city's residents and especially for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is both necessary and in the best public interest that Tyler County Texas, avail itself of the Community Development Block Grant Program for Small Cities, under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974;


WHEREAS, certain deficiencies in public facilities serving low to moderate income families in Tyler County will be corrected;

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners Court has designed its program of activities for the Community Development Block Grant Program based on the recommendations from the Citizen Participation and Public Hearing meeting held on October 7, 1982;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS:


1. THAT a Community Development Block Grant Application be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a Single Purpose Grant to improve certain deficiencies in public facilities serving low and moderate income persons.
2. THAT the County Commissioners Court direct and designate Allen Sturrock as the County's Chief Executive Officer and authorized representative to act in all matters in connection with this Application and the County's participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program.

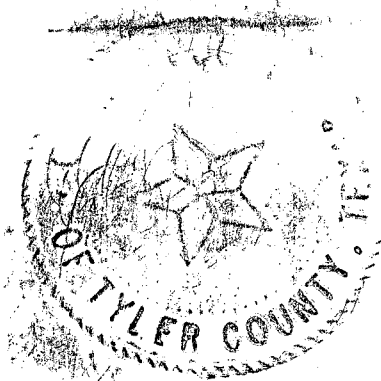

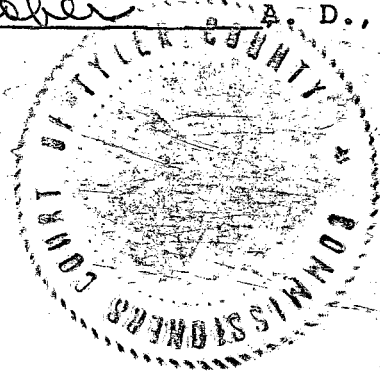


