A Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court, met on Monday January 10, 1983 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present, except Commissioner H.K. Lowe. The meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to accept the County Treasurers Monthly Report. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to accept the County Extension Monthly Report. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to give J.P. Pct. #1 Wanda Brasher permission to attend the J.P. Seminar on January 31, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to accept the Bid of Phillips Heating and Air Conditioning, for a Tower and Rotating Beacon, for the Airport. This was the only Bid presented, and was at the cost of \$3,895.00. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

Because of an increase in the price of paper, County Clerk, Grace Bostick, asked the Court to recommend an increase in the pay scale of making copies for the Attorneys. The original price of \$.35 to \$.50 per page. A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to recommend this. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to table the Bids on Xerox Paper until Friday Jan. 14, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

All voted yes and none no. Judge Sturrock is over the maintenance of the Court-house.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to advertise for Bids on a Typewriter for the County Treasurers Office. Bids to be opened Feb. 14, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table a request of Brad Smith, until Friday Jan. 14, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to solicit Bids on two used dump trucks, in Pct. # 3, for sale. These trucks may be seen at the Pct. 3 maintenance barn in Colmesneil. Bids to be opened Feb. 14, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Riley to solicit bids to purchase a used Maintainer for Pct. IV. Bids to be opened Friday Jan. 14, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve Surety Bonds for all elected Officials. All voted yes and none no. See attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to appoint J.P.#1 Wanda Brasher as the County's Registrar. This includes Births and Deaths for 1983. All voted yes and none no. She will also hold hearings.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to adopt a Resolution, for all County Officials to be paid on a Salary Basis for 1983. All voted yes and none no. Copy of letter to Hon. Bob Bullock, Comptroller of Public Accounts, Austin, Texas 78774 attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Odom and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to table the selecting of a Grievance Committee for 1983, until Friday Jan. 14, 1983. All voted yes and none no.

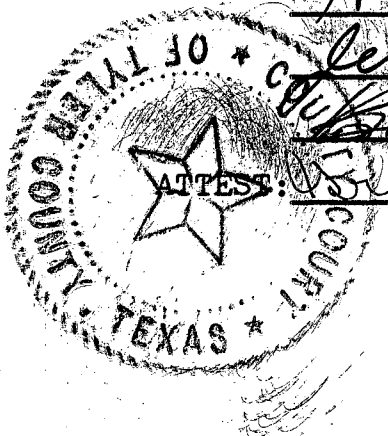
