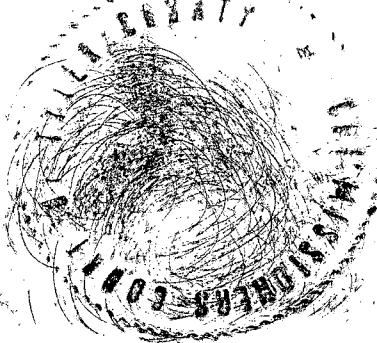

He shall carefully keep an oversight of same to see that the expenses of any department do not exceed said budget appropriation, and keep said court advised of the condition of said appropriation accounts from time to time."

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WHEREAS, by Right of Way Deed dated March 14, 1964 and recorded in Volume 208, Page 623 et seq., Deed Records of Tyler County, Texas, J. G. WHEREAS, it stipulated in said Right of Way Deed if the 50' wide strip ceased to be used as a public road, then it would revert to the abutting owners proportionately to their frontage;

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared that said 50' strip of land was never used or maintained by the County of Tyler for roadway purposes, and the County of Tyler never intends to use and maintain same as a roadway, THEREFORE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, being the County Judge and all of the Commissioners of Tyler County, Texas, hereby consent to, approve of and adopt the following Resolution:

"RESOLVED, that the above described 50' wide strip of land conveyed by J. G. Haralson, Jr., to the County of Tyler in 1964, be hereby disbanded and forthwith returned to its rightful owners."

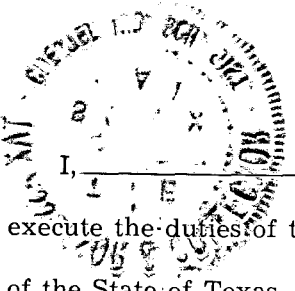

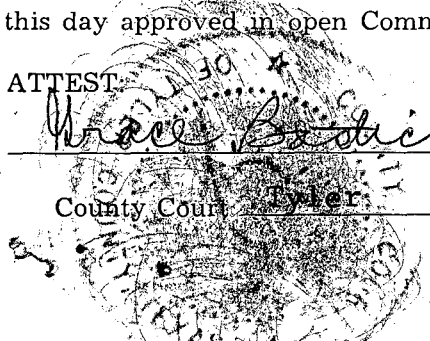

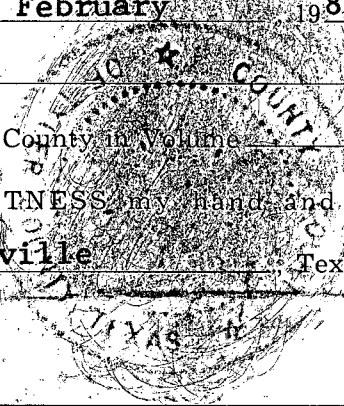
