A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Friday, March 18, 1983 at 10:00 A.M. All Members being present. The Meeting was opened with prayer by County Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the bid from Evans Insurance Agency on insurance for the Court-house and its' contents. St. Paul Insurance Co. will provide that coverage of \$1,284,600.00, with the total premium for one year being \$1,385.00, All Voted yes and none no. See Attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to accept the Contract with Citizens State Bank for County Depository. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to exercise the option with Deep East Texas Workmen's Compensation Insurance that the County consider paying salaries of employees injured on the job for the first ten (10) weeks of disability; after that, the Insurance Company will be allowed to take up weekly disability payments. Deep East Texas Workmen's Compensation will be responsible for payment of all other items. All voted yes and none no.

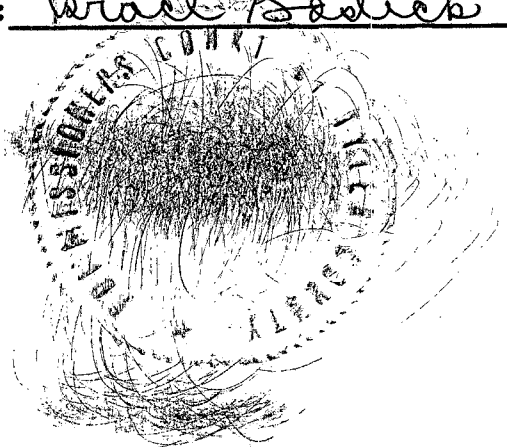
