The following equipment will be required by the Tyler County Commissioners for a two-way radio system for use in Road and Bridge work and for Civil Defense disaster coordination. Tyler County is seeking a complete turn-key system; no partial bids will be accepted. Bidder must provide name, address and business relationship of entity which will provide parts and labor warranty repair service.
