TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT
SPECIAL MEETING
DECEMBER 29, 1983----10:00 A. M.

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A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Thursday, December 29, 1983, at 10:00 A. M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by James Robert Jordan.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to accept the resignation of Berton Adnell Odom, Commissioner of Pct. #4, effective as of December 31, 1983, due to health problems. All voted yes and none no. See Attached. At the same time, Judge Allen Sturrock announced the appointment of James Robert Jordan as the new Commissioner of Pct. #4, replacing Mr. Odom.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to approve the paying of end of year bills, including a payment to the Tax Appraisal Board for the first quarter of 1984. All voted yes and none no. See Attached. At the same time, a motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve paying bills that were turned in to the County Auditor, Ann Nichol, too late to appear on the original Claims Register, from the Sheriff's Office and Pct. #1. These bills were submitted by County Auditor Ann Nichol. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

Bill Jefferson, Telephone Consultant, and James Stracener; representative from Direct Dialing Systems, appeared before the Court to discuss new phone systems for the County. After the question and answer session, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to hire Bill Jefferson as a telephone Consultant for the County, to advise the Commissioner's court on any decisions to be made concerning changes in the County's System. Mr. Jefferson's fee will be \$450.00 per year. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table any decision to be made concerning the acceptance of the 1981-82 Audit report, as submitted by Mr. Kennedy of Kennedy and Company, Houston, Texas, Independent Auditor, until further study could be made of the report. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to accept the one (1) bid received from B & M Logging Co., Beaumont, Texas, for a used 1975 GMC Winch Truck, to be used by Pct. #III. Bid received listed below:

B & M Logging Co.-----\$7000.00

All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve designating Monday, January 2, 1984, as a legal holiday for County employees. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Odom to grant Judge Allen Sturrock the authority to sign the Contrant with Texas Department of Community Affairs on the Block Grant. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Odom to table any discussion on a Disaster Plan for Tyler County until Monday, January 9, 1984 at 10:00 A. M. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Odom to advertise for bids for two (2) Flat Bed Trailers to be used by Pct. #I and Pct. #IV. Bids received to be opened on Monday, January 23, 1984, at 10:00 A. M. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to advertise for bids for a new Bulldozer, to be used by the Sanitary Land-fill Dept. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.

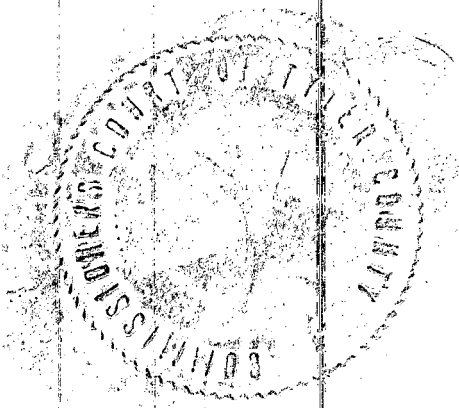




