A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to grant permission to Clifton Castilow, Warren, Texas, to build a hanger at the Tyler County Airport for his personal airplane, with Mr. Castilow to pay the rate of \$10.00 per month to Tyler County for rental purposes. All voted yes and none no.
