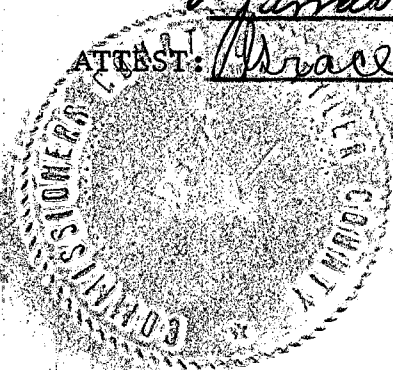



II, the FREE AND UNINTERRUPTED USE, LIBERTY, PRIVILEGE AND EASEMENT OF PASSING IN AND ALONG A CERTAIN WAY ACROSS A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND SITUATED IN TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS, described as follows, to-wit:

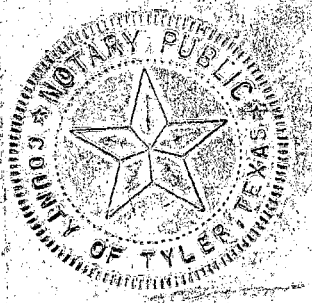
