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The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Monday, June 11, 1984, at 10:00 A. M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Commissioner James R. Jordan.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to adopt the resolution to start collecting an extra \$5.00 per vehicle registered in Tyler County as of January 1, 1985, as authorized in Article 6675a9a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes; proceeds shall be deposited in the County Road and Bridge Funds. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

At a Special Meeting held on Friday, May 18, 1984, Commissioner's Court authorized David Davis, a representative from Knapp Ford Co., Inc., to take the wrecked automobile belonging to the Sheriff's Department, to Insurance Storage Pool, Inc., Beaumont, Texas, for sale at auction. 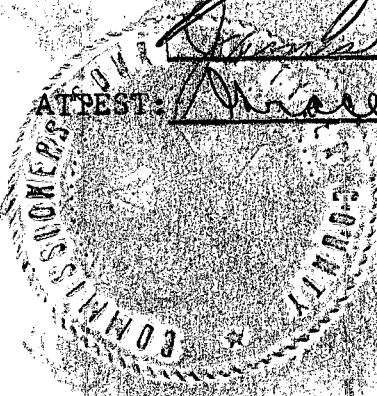




