> I write as attorney for Warren Independent School District for the purpose of requesting your assistance, and that of Commissioners Court, in the matter of a one acre tract of land owned by the school district.

In late 1916 Southwestern Settlement and Development Company deeded to B. L. Richardson, T. J. Hester and J. H. Holland, as trustees of the Pineville School District #37, Tyler County, Texas, and their successors, a one acre tract of land out of Abstract 307, Thomas Green Survey. I enclose herewith copy of such conveyancing instrument.

In 1927 the Pineville School District #37 was consolidated with Warren school district, an action which, I suppose, involved the approval of Commissioners Court. However, Tyler County Abstract Company is unable to find of record a deed from Commissioners Court or the Pineville Board of Trustees to Warren school district.

My purpose in writing to you is to request that Commissioners Court consider executing a deed conveying this tract formally to Warren Independent School District, in order that clear record title may be fixed in the school district. I have prepared and enclose such deed for your examination.

References in the minutes of Commissioners Court at the time of the consolidation of the Pineville District with the Warren District should serve as a basis for the execution of such a deed.

I have contacted Mr. Pat Hardy, County Attorney, concerning the matter. Mr. Hardy suggested that I write to you with the foregoing request.

If I can offer additional information or assistance I will be pleased to do so. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
