A Special Meeting of the Commissioners Court was held on Wednesday, May 29, 1985, at 1:00 P.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Commissioner James R. Jordan.

Members of Commissioners Court and the Jail Study Committee met this date to discuss the purchase of property as a site for the new County Jail, having asked Attorney James Dillion, Post Commander of V.F.W. Post #2033, Woodville, Texas, to appear before the court to report V.F.W. Post #2033 members' decision concerning the sale of their property, located on Willow Street, Woodville, Texas. At this time, Mr. Dillion stated that a decision had been reached at their meeting held on Tuesday Night, May 28, 1985, and that the members had decided to sell the County of Tyler three (3) acres of property located on Willow Street, Woodville, Texas, description of the property being the East side of the V.F.W. ten (10) acre tract, next to the railroad. After Mr. Dillion had finished stating this information, a motion was made by Jail Study Committee member John M. Wingate to recommend to Commissioners Court that this described property be purchased by the County for the new Jail site, and was seconded by Jail Study Committee member Jack B. Farquhar. The motion passed, with eight (8) voting for and four (4) against.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to recommend consideration of both listed properties, (The V.F.W. property located on Willow Street, and the J. T. Lindsey property, located on Highway 69 North) pending an Architect's examination of both of these locations. All voted yes and none no.

George E. Cooper, Jr., Vice President-bond Consultant for Schneider, Bernet & Hickman, Inc., of Longview, Texas, and acting as the County's financial advisor, appeared before the Court to discuss proper procedures for obtaining funds for the new Jail building and land. No decisions were made.

EMERGENCY SESSION:

Grace Bostick, County Clerk, and Patricia Brown, District Clerk, met with the Court, expressing the need for two (2) new copy machines, one for each of their offices, and stating that funds were available for the purchase of these machines. After some discussion on this matter, a motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to allow both County Clerk Bostick and District Clerk Brown to solicit bids for the new machines, bids received to be opened on Monday, June 10, 1985, at 10:00 A.M. All voted yes and none no.


SPECIAL SESSION:

Sheriff Leon Fowler and his Deputy, Max Langston, met with the Court to discuss problems in the Sheriff's Department caused by the newly enacted Wage and Hour Law, caused by the Supreme Court's handing down the Garcia Decision, originating through the Federal Labor Relations Board, San Antonio, Texas. After Deputy Langston had reported how various other Counties were handling this situation, a motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to grant permission to the Sheriff's Department and/or any other Departments being affected by the more than forty (40) hour work week, to try to work out a solution to the problem, whereby employees would not have to work more than forty (40) hours per week. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve a tentative bid of \$38,500.00 for a used 1980 Mack Truck, to be used by Precinct #3, less \$10,000.00 trade-in of a 1978 Chevrolet Truck, from Barrett Mack Sales & Service, Lufkin, Texas; since no bids were received by Court time. All voted yes and none no. See Attached.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
