A Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court was held on Tuesday, November 12, 1985 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Commissioner Jordan.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe to approve the County Extension Monthly report. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graham. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Graham made a motion to table the approval of the County Auditor's Monthly Report until the Friday meeting, November 15, 1985. This will give the commissioners more time to review the report. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Lowe made a motion to approve the Tyler County Probation report. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to adopt a resolution of casting the entity's one vote for Barbara Tolbert as a Director on the Tyler County Tax Appraisal Board. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to set and approve a 30% tax exemption for homesteads only. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Graham to set and approve a tax exemption of \$11,400.00 for "over 65" taxpayers. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Graham to set and approve the State mandated tax exemption of \$3000.00 on County Special Fund only. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to approve to County Auditor's request request for payment of Monthly Allowances and travel as submitted by the County Auditor, Ann Strickland. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graham. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Jordan made a motion to go into session to canvass the results of the 1985 Constitutional Amendment Election. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graham. All voted yes and none no.

CANVASS: Discrepancies found: Box #1: Proposition #8-had 53 FOR 32 AGAINST = 85 with only 84 voters voting.  
Box #8: Proposition #8 had 10 FOR and 11 AGAINST=21 with only 20 voters voting.  
Box #15: Proposition #5 shows 27 FOR and 33 AGAINST= 60 with only 59 voters voting. Also there were 59 voters instead of 53.  
Absentee: total voted was 93 instead of 92

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to approve the returns of the Constitutional Amendment Election of November 5, 1985 with the above changes of votes cast for the propositions. All voted yes and none no.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.

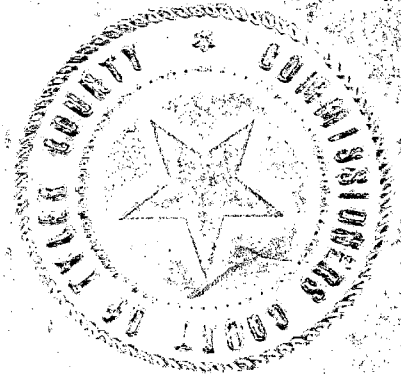

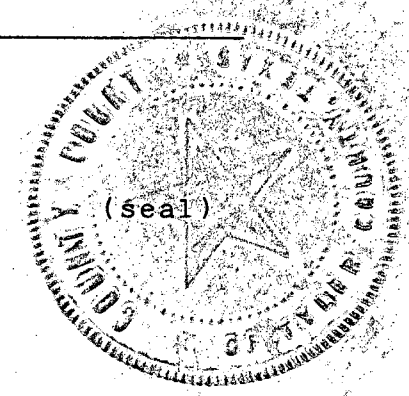

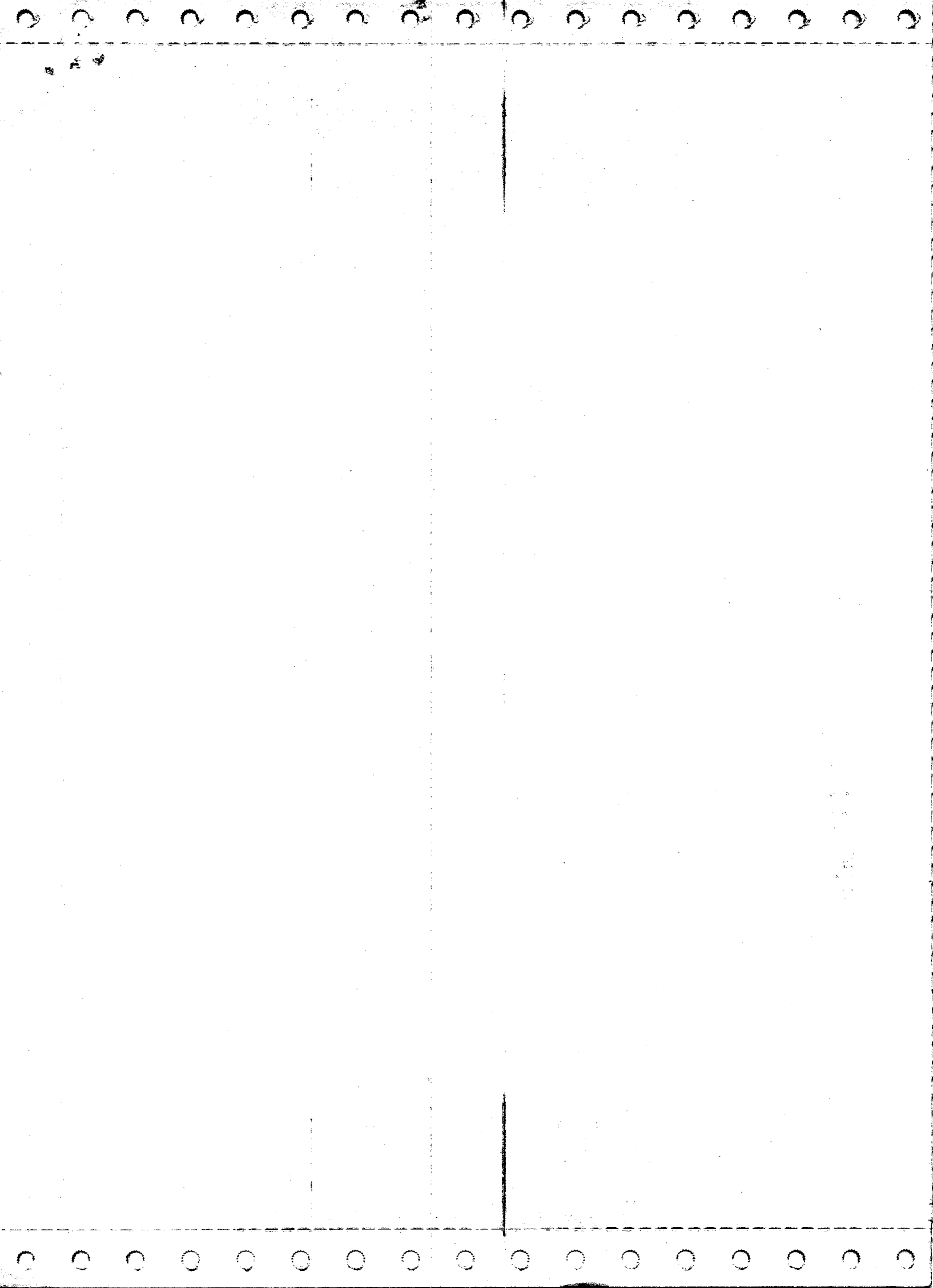
