The Regular Meeting of the Commissioner's Court met on Monday, February 10, 1986 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Commissioner Jordan.

David Waxman, Grant Administrator, held a public hearing on Flood Plains for the area concerned with the construction of the Old Doucette Road and Turkey Creek Bridge. Henry Read and wife, Margaret and David Lefkovitz and wife, Dorothy, all in attendance at the hearing, gave comments with concern about the road surface being liable to potholes and speeding traffic.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Graham to sell the Utility brand float trailer to the highest bidder being Leo Connor for \$2,900.95. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to accept plats of Lake Camelot, Section Two and Lake Tristan, Section Two for recording and filing purposes only, meaning no expenses to the County. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley to adopt by order authorizing publication of notice of intention to issue Certificates of Obligation in the amount of \$1,800,000.00 for payment of construction and equipping the county jail and other fees in connection with the project. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Lowe. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to approve the County Extension Monthly Report. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Lowe. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to table approving the County Treasurer's Monthly Report and the County Auditor's Monthly Report for further study until Friday, February 14, 1986. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Lowe and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve the payment of monthly allowances and travel including a bill from Motorola as submitted by the County Auditor, Ann Strickland. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan to approve the deputation of Debbie Pittman as a deputy for the District Clerk's office. Commissioner Lowe seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to set the date of March 10, 1986 at 1:30 P.M. till 2:30 P.M. for public hearing on Weight Limits on bridges and roads marked by posted signs. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Lowe to table setting specific payroll dates for further study until Friday, February 14, 1986. All voted yes with the exception of Commissioner Riley voting no.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE MEETING ADJOURNED.

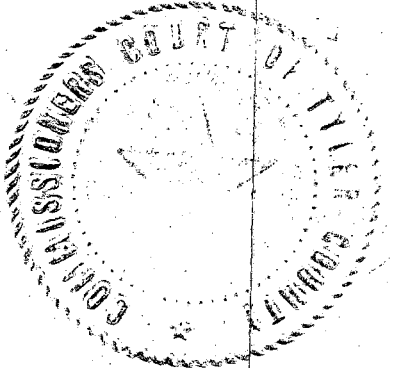



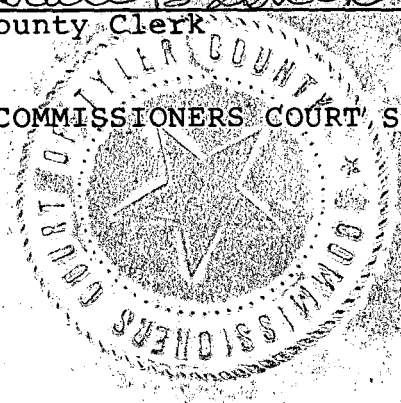

ORDER
AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE
CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

THE STATE OF TEXAS :
COUNTY OF TYLER :

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that an improvement program is urgently needed for constructing and equipping a county jail; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court deems it advisable to give notice of intention to issue certificates of obligation in the amount of \$1,800,000 for the purpose of paying all or a portion of the County's contractual obligations for constructing and equipping a county jail, and to pay legal, fiscal and architectural fees in connection with this project, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that a case of emergency or urgent public necessity exists which requires the holding of the meeting at which this Order is passed, such emergency or urgent public necessity being that the notice of intention to issue certificates of obligation should be published as soon as possible and without delay for necessary and urgently needed public improvements; and that said meeting was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Art. 6252-17, V.A.T.C.S.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TYLER COUNTY:

1. That attached hereto is a form of the Notice of Intention to issue Certificates of Obligation, the form and substance of which is hereby adopted and approved.

2. That the County Clerk shall cause said notice to be published in substantially the form attached hereto, in a newspaper of general circulation in said County, and published in said County, on the same day in each of two consecutive weeks, the date of the first publication thereof to be at least 14 days prior to the time set for the issuance of such certificates of obligation as shown in said notice.

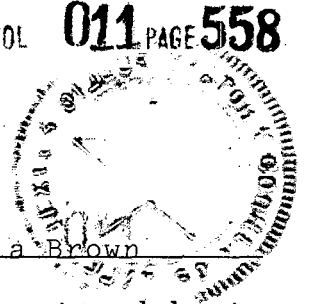
