A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court was held on Tuesday, February 3, 1987 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Commisisoner Jordan.

Victor Cain was ill and was not able to attend the meeting. The item on solid waste law changes will be presented in a future meeting.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Graham to appoint Jack Whitmeyer, Manie Whitmeyer, Phebe Armstrong, Dolores Gibson, Vivian Jordan, Jane Mann, Ewel Wood, Marjorie Wood, Stephanie Yearwood and Barbara Phillips to the Tyler County Historical Commission. The appointments will be for two years. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Barnes made a motion to approve the bond of Barbara Smith as Tax Assessor/Collector for the Spurger Independent School District. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graham. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham to approve payment of the bill from A.I.D. architectural firm for services on the new jail. (\$9,773.99) Commissioner Conner seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

COMMISSIONER CONNER EXCUSED HIMSELF FROM THE COURTROOM

After much discussion, A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan to approve the payment of the bill from Woodville Auto Parts for parts purchased by the sheriff's department. (\$124.24) Commissioner Jordan also stated that in the future that other automotive businesses should be considered first due to a "conflict of interest" with Commissioner Conner being the owner of Woodville Auto Parts. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graham. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

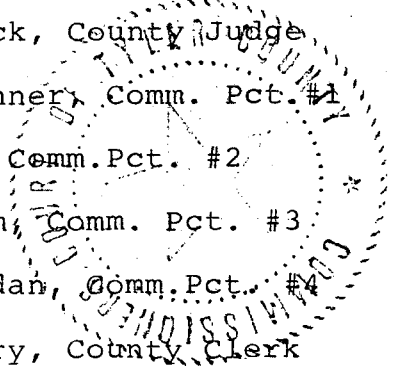

Wade Skinner, Chief-Deputy Sheriff, presented to the court Art.988b V.T.C.S. which he interprets to read that it would not be illegal to purchase parts from Woodville Auto Parts as long as Commissioner Conner abstained from a vote or decision on the matter. No motions were made. Judge Sturrock recommended that affidavits be filed as result.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham for the emergency purchase of a 1978 Chevrolet 1-ton, flat bed truck for Precinct #3. Purchase price being \$2000.00. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no.
